THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Governor Brereton Jones spoke about Health Care Reform. 450,000 Kentuckians have no helth insurance but they do not make campaign contributions. We must not forget these people. As we help these people, we help ourselves. It is a win/win situation. We must stop cost shifting where these insured people get care in the hospital emergency room. Governor Jones' goals are to cut health care costs and get control of these costs; provide coverage for the 450,000 uninsured Kentuckians; and make it illegal to discriminate because of pre-existing conditions. This is a socictal problem and we should not point the finger of blame. If we do not address the problem, we are looking at a 12-15% increase next year. We will have to take that money from someone else or reduce health care coverage of state employees. Every other state has failed in solving this problem because they tried to reach a political solution and thus could not get control of costs. A Health Care Access Committee began in 1983. Kentucky physicians agreed to treat people for free who do not qualify for Medicare or Medicaid. A Megapool is the answer. Governor Jones is proposing a Health Care Authority to take charge of a nine and one half billion dollar industry. The Authority will set rates for physicians/drugs etc. Also hospitals should not be competing with other hospitals.

Tom Loftus, Frankfort bureau chief who covers state government affairs for the Louisville Courier-Journal, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, May 19, 1993.

Mr. Loftus, in cooperation with seventy-two other Courier-Journal staff members, won the coveted Pulitzer Prize for their coverage of the 1988 Carrollton bus crash. He is probably the only person that has requested and received a Kentucky Colonelcy for a dog! (We never did hear his comments about that accomplishment)

In his speech today, Mr. Loftus offered the following observations about Operation BOPTROT:

- 1. The trials of the individuals accused in the scandel were a public service for all Kentuckians. If everyone had plead guilty and there had been no trials, the public would have missed the details that surfaced as a result of the trials.
- The tatics used by the FBI during Operation BOPTROT would have never been challenged if not presented in the courtroom.

The speaker for the day was Carolyn Blackburn who has been in education for over 30 years. She spoke about KERA (Kentucky Education Reform Act) and private and public school education. She strongly supports KERA and everyone is affected by it. In 1980, the federal government issued a report entitled "A Nation at Risk". It was a highly critical report on education which cannot be set aside from society. It does not matter how many degrees you have but what is important is what you are going to do for the students. Teachers have always known what helps to improve teaching but now one asked them. Teachers know what works and what does not work. Thins will never be the same again after KERA. With teachers being consulted, real positive changes will be made. We must look at the whole KERA picture even though there may be parts of it you do not like. We all have to be educators and cannot leave it solely to the schools. It takes a whole village to raise a child. We must all work together to educate our children. KERA will succeed in many ways. Carolyn also spoke about the effect of KERA on indepent schools. There are various alternative schools in Frankfort. We need to find the school the child can fit into and feel comfortable in. Parents perceive that independent schools have high ethical standard and expectations. There are also small classes.
