#### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for the day was Bruce C. Cottin, Sr. Vice President for Public Relations for Long John Silvers. He spoke about Rotary and Long John Silvers. Concerning Rotary, he has visited all three Clubs in Juneau, Alaska. There is a rivalry between the clubs for members and in sports. However, all three clubs band together for civic deeds in a city of only 15,000. By contrast, his home town of Lexington only has one club. Singapore has seven clubs which have lengthy programs and fellowship. In clubs he has visited such as in Alaska and Singapore, the members all seem to be happy but in his home club, the members do not seem to enjoy Rotary as much. Concerning Long John Silvers, the company buys fish from the North Pacific Fishing Council and last year purchased 175 million pounds of live weight fish. Long John Silvers feeds 600,000 people per day and 219 million per year in their restaurants. 34 states, Singapore, Saudi Arabia, Canada and soon Mexico also have restaurants. In Saudi Arabia, a half brother to the king is a franchisee who is also the governor of Medina restaurants and take them to places where visitors are found such as in Mecca. Long John Silvers was bought out in 1989 for \$620 million. There are at present 1462 restaurants worldwide.



Joe Clark, Speaker of the Kentucky House of Representatives spoke. He practices law in Danville with his wife Anne, and probably needed no introduction to the attendees. 

#### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Ms. Marilyn Moosnick, volunteer extraordinare with the Kentucky Arts Council, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, July 21, 1993.

Ms. Moosnick gave a brief history of the arts in Kentucky. In 1963, President Kennedy established the National Endowment for the Arts which provided federal funds to states to develop arts commissions/councils. The first Kentucky Arts Commission began in 1964. Since then there have been five executive directors. Two weeks ago, Governor Jones appointed the sixth executive director - Lou DeLuca. Mr. DeLuca is a lawyer, architect and educator and will be an excellent leader on behalf of the Kentucky Arts Council.

Ms. Moosnick reported that Frankfort has received during the past three years approximately \$171,969 in grants. These funds provide programming for the following entities: The Frankfort Arts Foundation, Kentucky Historical Society, Pegasus Players, Downtown Frankfort and Bluegrass Theatre Guild.

In closing, Ms. Moosnick asked that as Rotarians we do the following three things: 1.) if you are ever asked to be on a board of an arts organization/council - please say yes!; 2.) if you have the opportunity to talk to your local legislative representative, compliment your community arts programs and comment on how they have enhanced your life/community;



#### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Jim Thomas, President and CEO of "Shakertown at Pleasant Hill, Kentucky, Inc.", spoke on the history of the "Shaker" movement, and their need for Capital funds. The background of the founder, Mother Anne, was fascinating. She apparently survived an early disastrous marriage, was functionally illiterate, was a "pest" to the established church in England in the late 1700's, and was actively encouraged by the church to seek religious freedom in this country. In Kentucky, the "Shakers" prospered. By 1830, some 500 people lived in some 260 structures on over 4000 acres of land; before the movement started to decline. The community was officially active from 1805 to 1910, and literally "went to sleep" from then to 1961, when the non-profit corporation was formed. Amazingly, they have NO federal or state funding, and only two percent (2%) of their operating budget comes from contributions and endowment interest. They have 200 employees, a \$6,000,000 operating budget, and an economic impact on their part of Kentucky. However, deferred maintenance must be done, and they are starting a minimum of \$5,000,000 capital campaign.
