INTERNATIONAL SERVICE

Alan Hamilton, Chairman of Kryie, introduced Jeff Hancock and his exchange student from Italy, Ricardo Scarobo. Jeff has previously traveled to Italy to visit in Ricardo's home. Ricardo presented a banner from a Rotary Club in his home town in Italy.

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for the day was Agriculture Commissioner, ed Logsdon. Commissioner Logsdon stated that he has 350 Employees and 61% of his duties involve regulatory matter. The other 39% involves educating people, especiall in urban areas, about agriculture. The Agriculture Department is involved in environmental issues and economic development. Middle schools have been visited by agriculture officials to tell students how agriculture affects them in their everday lives. For example, the students discuss how a pizza is made up of various agricultural products. Grants are also made to FFA and 4-H programs. Scholarships are made available through the Governors Scholars Program. An Office of Environmental Advocacy has been started in the Agriculture Dept. As far as economic development is concerned, agriculture should be treated as another industry. 69% of farmers have off-farm income. However, 70% of Kentucky's food is imported. We need more value added and supporting industries in Kentucky. Farming is a \$3.2 Billion industry which should be \$5 Billion by the year 2000. Tobacco is 26% of total farm income. This needs to be lowered in case something happens to the tobacco market. Kentucky has the biggest beef industry east of the Mississippi. The Free Trade agreement should help most Kentucky farmers.
