The speaker for the day was Maurice "Mo" Hunt, the head football coach at Kentucky State University. He introduced a receiver, Sean Stevenson and quarterback Clark Mitchell. 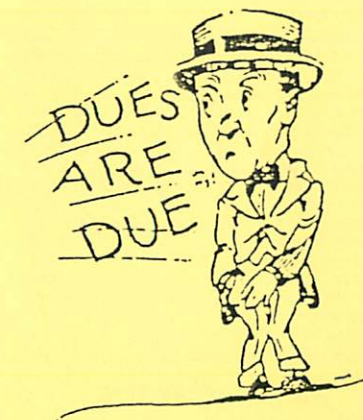

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Richard Balding, state archivist, discussed the role that archives play as part of the Kentucky Department of Libraries and Archives and their importance in documenting Kentucky's history.

Archives is part of the public records division within the Department of Libraries and Archives, and it provides records management to state agencies, to local government entities, to judicial officers in all 120 counties and other local district governing bodies. It was created to assure the creation and preservation of documents of government agencies. Mr. Belding noted that while all government records are public, not all public records are subject to the Open Records Law.

Archives provides many services including economically feasible records storage - 182 million pages are now stored in their original form - litigation support, and stored in their original form - litigation support, and research ervices. Archives maintains records very systematically, determining what is to be kept, how the records are to be kept, and what they are to be transferred from the agency to Archives.

Morris Burton, Franklin County's Attorney, was the special guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, September 15, 1993.

Mr. Burton has been the Commonwealth attorney in Franklin County for nine and a half years. He prosecutes felony crimes and some misdemeanor crimes if they are committed in conjunction with a felony crime.

Mr. Burton provided very interesting statistics about the rising crime rate in Franklin County. He compared crime statistics compiled for 1980 and 1992.

	1980	1992
Total Arrest:	4,662	6,056
Violent/Serious Crimes:	343	701
Drug Related Crimes	210	375

Mr. Burton also expressed great concern about the unusually high number of physical and sexual abuse cases involving children in Franklin County.

The average level of education for those committing crimes in today's society is somewhere between the 7th and 10th grade. Mr. Burton cited success with the probationary requirement for those who do not have a high school diploma that they attend GED classes.

Our speaker was A. B. Ben Chandler, Auditor of Public Accounts. He was recently selected Outstanding Young Lawyer.

He began his career five years ago in Versailles and is the grandson of Happy Chandler.

His ties to Frankfort are strong as he lived 3 months in the mansion when he was a baby and his wife is from Frankfort.

Ben asked, "how many of us like politics?", and concluded that we love democracy but hate politics. He went on to say that the word politics makes us think of corruption, and that we constantly see evidence of it in the media. "Democracy is Politics" he stated, and politics have brought us our geatest leaders and all of the freedoms we enjoy. We are equal with everyone and have equal say.

He said we need to keep the good part of Politics which are accountabil-ity and honesty, and that people need to see results. We need to change the publics view that the government is the enemy by shining a light on politicians, making them accountable and instilling trust. Additionally, he said steward-ship is the idea of taking what is given to you and improving it or pre-serving it. He gave the example of the time he and his 86 year old grandfather planted walnuts along a fence row.

He concluded by saying, "if we have accountability and stewardship maybe we would not have this gap between democr-acy and politics."
