### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for the day was Betsy Goldsworthy of the Woodbridge Academy in Midway for persons with "attention deficiency." This is not a learning disability or disorder which is a misnomer. The students have auditory and visual problems. She demonstrated the problem with a doll. Is it Little Red Riding Hood, the wolf or the grandmother? In such cases, the brain has to make a detour when a neuron is cut, Woodbridge is different from a public school and has no specific program. It teaches students many skills they will need later on. The students often have above average intelligence but cannot handle traditional school environment. A typical class has 6-8 students. The job is not to lecture but to be on a learning team. The students learn to adapt to dyslexia. Success equals equality and cooperation. Social skills are taught and the students also choose what they are interested in and use technology as part of the learning process. An example is the study of sink-holes on which the students prepare presentations and even make them to legislators. The presentations are also made to each other and the students see they are learning real life skills. Woodbridge is even ahead of KERA. The goals for graduation are (1) Read and interpret (2) Speak fluently (3) Apply mathematics (4) See themselves as active citizens (5) Synthesize information using technology. 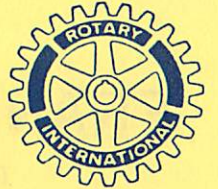

**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Dr. Leon Booth, President of Northern Kentucky University (NKU), was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, October 20, 1993.

Dr. Booth was appointed President of NKU in 1983. This year marks NKU's 25th anniversary and Chase College of Law is celebrating its 100th anniversary. NKU boasts a current enrollment of over 12,000 students and 20,000 alumni members.

Dr. Booth believes that the following principals have guided the development of NKU: 1.) Restore respect to undergraduate teaching; 2.) Assure that faculty are available to students (average student/teacher ratio is 25-35 to 1); 3.) Truth in advertising regarding class size; and 4.) Place student needs at the center of the curriculum.

Economically, NKY's budget creates over 8,000 jobs and returns approximately \$220 million in revenue to the Northern Kentucky area. NKU is the first university to embark on a fund-raiser entitled the "Capital Campaign:." The base goal of this fund-raiser is \$10 million and the victory goal is \$15 million. To date faculty and staff have already donated over \$900,000.

Thank you Dr. Booth for your interesting and informative speech about Northern Kentucky University.

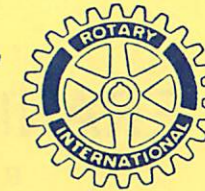

## THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our speaker was Dr. Robert Botkin, president of Midway College. Kentucky's only 4 year college for women. Chartered in 1847 as a junior college, it's early history was to train girls, predominately from broken homes, how to work. During its later history, they started, and eventually closed, a school with lower classes. Our speaker was hired in 1985 to head a college of 300+ students and 50+ faculty, with endowment income plunging due to lower interest rates, and dropping oil income. Needless to say, he found a challenge. In looking for a plan of action for Midway, he decided to change it to four year college, still for women only. AAUW studies show that in a co-ed institution, boys tend to be quarterbacks, and girls tend to be cheerleaders. He feels that Kentucky needs at least one all women college, and did that best he could to convince us of his opinion. Enrollment at the Midway campus is now 600+, with between 950 and 1000 total students being served by the college at all of its facilities. He is certainly an enthusiastic president, and as President John Palmore said in closing, an inspired booster of the college, and should join the lecture circuit, carrying his message.
