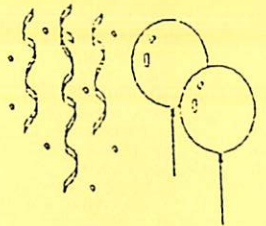

We welcome the newest member of our club, William Thomas Cockley. William was introduced by Leroy Smith. His classification will be College & Universities - Physical Education.

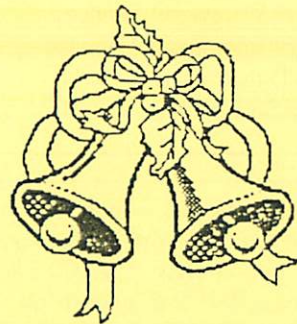
We look forward to sharing Rotary fellowship and service with William in the years to come.

**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Ron Crouch, director of the Kentucky State Data Center at the University of Louisville, was Rotary's quest speaker. Mr. Crouch has been dubbed "Mr. Data" by The Courier-Journal because of his vast knowledge gleaned from the 1990 census.

Mr. Crouch stated that there are population changes occurring now in the United States that must be responded to. A major problem facing this nation is the aging population -- more and more people are between 61 - 100 years old -- and how funding for social security and retirement benefits are shrinking.

Mr. Crouch said that during the next 20 years, 80 percent of the total population growth will be in the 65-year and over category. People today are living longer and he suggested that we need to redefine what "old age" means. People are retiring too early, and we should seek solutions in systems that will enable rather than disable people to live longer, healthier, more productive lives.

**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Our speaker was Art Williams, President of the Board of Directors of SCENIC KENTUCKY. A former Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection, Art is now an attorney, and a new Rotarian, in Louisville. Most people know what they do or don't like based on the senses of feel, sounds, and taste. A more subjective problem is that of sight - which SCENIC KENTUCKY is addressing. The problem is "Quality of Life". Kim Klein, the Executive Director of SCENIC KENTUCKY, presented a series of slides showing the contrast between pleasant scenes in Kentucky, and Visual Pollution. A recent study found on a six mile stretch of I-65 between the airport and downtown Louisville, there were 54 bill-boards and 101 advertisements. Too often the mayor looks for alternate routes to avoid the embarrassment of this. SCENIC KENTUCKY is pushing to reduce "sign clutter" and increase the number of trees -- especially in mall parking lots. In Charlotte, NC, a new ordinance calls for every new road to be tree-lined. This is not an easy issue, nor does it have a life or death significance - but - our visual environment impacts our overall "Quality of Life."

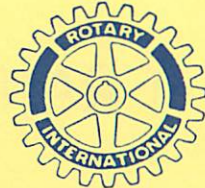

The speaker today was Jackie Badgett-Harper, daughter of Pat Badgett. And owner of Jackie & Company, Inc. located at Franklin Square Shopping Center. Jackie spoke about the importance of exercise in the cure and prevention of cardio-vascular disease. She started out giving some shocking statistics. 29% of Kentuckians smoke, which is first in the nation. Everyday 27 Kentuckians die of coronary heart disease. 15% have high blood pressure. Jackie spoke about the dangers of hypertension, lack of physical activity, smoking and high blood pressure. Kentucky is 8th in the nation in obesity. She listed several important reasons to exercise: 1.) Lose excess weight, 2.) Relax from tension, 3.) Keeps us physically and mentally alert, 4.) A more congenial attitude towards our family and co-workers and 5.) Add years to our life. Three or four times a week we need to do something active. We need to exercise our heart muscle like any other body muscle. Lower back pain can be prevented by exercising the abdominal muscles. Jackie and Company has personal trainers who can design various exercise programs. Drinking water is also important. Jackie & Company has 3 aerobic classes a day. They are at 12:00 p.m., 5:00 p.m. and 6:15 p.m. These are low impact aerobics classes. Jackie then proceeded to demonstrate aerobic exercise techniques for the biceps and triceps. It is important to strengthen the stomach to keep our back in shape.

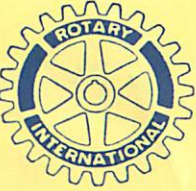
