### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for the day was Tom Kenney, newscaster for WLEX-TV. He is a former All-American basketball player from Peoria, Illinois. When an injury ended his college career, the only coach who called to say he was sorry was Bobby Knight. As to the news business, he stated that he has to constantly defend the media from criticism, much of which is justified. He is appalled at the way the media has covered the O. J. Simpson case. Reporters have gone from telling the public simply what happened to giving their personal interpretations. Reporters today act like amateur psychologists. They have gotten away from just telling you what happened. Good news does not sell only bad news and tragic events. This can be beneficial as in Ethiopia, Television is powerful but it is often used in the wrong ways. For example, a charge against a public figure can be unfounded but often no follow-up is done if the person is found not guilty. It is irresponsible for the media not to follow-up stories. The media often loses sensitivity. Many people are not watching news programs like they used to. Both the media and viewers must bear the responsibility. Our priorities are simply not right. The news director has the ultimate say if there is a problem as to what to report. Also the producer exercises alot of power. As to a question about the reliability of news tips on the tips hot line, 9 out of 10 tips are dead ends.



#### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our guest speaker on August 18, 1994 was Bob Babbage, Secretary of State. Secretary Babbage worked hard for the implementation of new voter registration programs in Kentucky that have gained national recognition as recordingsetting. He has a strong record on ethics in government. While State Auditor, he put into place programs to investigate waste and mismanagement of public funds and implemented a code of ethics for his office.

Secretary Babbage said the ethical voice must come from all of us and especially from those who are in public office. He says there are lessons to be learned and that recently some lessons have been learned as some who have made errors in thics have paid the price. We have also learned that the system works.

Secretary Babbage noted several of his recommendations to relative to the ethics issue. Among them:

- 1. Educate the coming generation
- 2. Create an independent Office of Inspector General
- 3. Continue support of campaign finance laws
- 4. Support election reform laws
- Invest in our own people for Kentucky's workforce instead of stealing folks from someplace else.

When asked what he thought about candidates for Governor and Lieutenant. Governor running as a slate, Secretary Babbage said it is a problem. He says



Ms. Geneva Straub, mental health nurse with the Turning Point Center and wife of fellow Rotarian Dr. Gary Straub, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, August 17, 1994.

Ms. Straub talked to club members about stress management and stress reduction. Stress is defined as the physical or emotional response that follows our interpretation of events (stressors) i.e. job pressures, family responsibilities, teenagers even traffic! These external events are an invitation for you to react. Usually our reactions produce negative effects to our body and mind — such as headaches, stomachaches, heart palpitations, and depression.

How can we reduce or better handle the stressful situations in our lives? The following suggestions are provided:

\*Change the way you react to troublesome things. Try to sharpen your awareness skills and monitor your internal responses.

\*Reduce the number of events in your life. If you take on a new responsibility, then drop something else in your life. Set real priorities.

\*Change the way you look at things. Mike Oder Practice positive self-talk and imagery. Develop a sense of humor and learn to laugh at yourself! Your info

\*Learn to moderate your responses. In other words, why hate when you can simply dislike; why feel anxious when you can feel nervous



### NEXT WEEK'S SPEAKER

Next week's speaker will be Virginia Fox, Executive Director of KET. Her topic will be Violance on Television and Advantages of Local Broadcasting.

### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for the day was Dr. Robert Mariner. The theme of his talk is that we should not take the human body for granted. The average human inhales and exhales about 23,000 times every 24 hours which is 2500 gallons of air. Yet we breathe without even thinking about it. The average adult looks at his watch 100-300 times a day, but Dr. Mariner asked that we do not look at our body as casually as we look at our watches. He cited some other statistics. We eat 50 tons during a lifetime and speak 48,000 words in the course of a day. We exercise 7 million brain cells a day. The brain is a chemical factory and sendsout thousands of messages at once. Three million impluses are sent out yet we use only 3-6% of our brain. The heart beats 100,000 times in one day or 35 million times a year. Yet we take our hearts for granted. The three leading causes of mortaility in order are heart disease, cancer and stroke. These are all life style diseases. We all play a major role in allowing these disease processes. We should all make life style modifications and good food is the best medicine. Excessive protein causes osteoporosis. We should eat less protein in our diets. Cancer cells can live without oxygen but hea-1thy cells cannot. Everyone has cancer cells in their bodies. We don't need full spectrum lighting, he said plants do better in it. Concerning sound, waltz music is better than rock music which causes confusion and disorientation. No wonder teenagers are so confused. Dr. Mariner ended his talk by saying we should not take our health or life for granted.
