The speaker for the day was former Franklin County Representative Hank Hancock. After he retired from the General Assembly he was made Executive Director of the Kentucky Association of Plumbing, Heating and Cooling. He stated that as he travels throughout the state in his new job, people express amazement that he was born and raised in Frankfort and that he served in the legislature 21 years. Abner Lipps, local humorist entertained and left Rotarians with several important messages relating to traffic safety. Among them:

- 1. If your vehicle stalls on a railroad track, immediately leave the vehicle and run toward the train to avoid the debris from the impact.
- 2. 96% of people attending traffic school in the Bluegrass area say they have had a drink and statistics show that 8 out of that 10 will drink and drive.

Allow One Hour Per 1/2 ounce of liquor befor driving

Alcohol provides a sense of selfconfidence; therfore, people drinking think they're driving great.

3. More accidents and injuries occur at intersections than any place else.

Don't Try To Outrun A Changing Light—You Can't Do It! Yellow means stop; not speed up to get through the light. Tickets are given based on what color the light is when the vehicle leaves the intersection.

Always stop completely at stop signs wherever they are.

Look bothe ways before you take off when the light turns green.

### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker was Darrell Gilliam, the new head of the Capital Community Economic / Industrial Development Authority. Although only in Frankfort since September 1994, Dale has had a number of jobs in the economic development area in the past 18 years. To show us what 18 years looks like, we saw a photograph of Dale 18 years ago. The Authority has 3 missions: (1) to recruit new industry (they have contacted 55 different firms since last September - industry goes where they are invited, and stay where they feel welcome); (2) work with existing development groups (they are jointly developing a strategic economic development plan - problem this area has a low unemployment rate and the number of people of working age declined from 1970 to 1990); and (3) work with existing industry.

#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The club was fortunate to have two good speakers. The first was Pam Clay who is the Director of Organic Growers. This project is 1 1/2 years old and is a pilot project of Kentucky Burley Growers. The goal is to help farmers diversify and still make a living on the farm. In encouraging farmers to grow organic vegetables this satisfies 1.) pest control people 2.) professional people 3.) Tobacco farmers 4.) The Land. All benefit: The goal is also to connect urban people to rural people. Subscribers get what is grown in a particular season and we see the variety of crops that can be grown in Kentucky. Unfortunately, 80-90% of the food consumed in Kentucky is imported. Home grown products are usually of better quality than those imported. In responding to questions from the floor, Pam made the following observations 1.) 12 produces signed-up last year to participate in the cooperative and 31 so far this vear. 2.) Through the cooperative, one can talk directly to the people who grow the food. 3.) There is a farmers' warehouse in New Haven and direct distribution in Ana-Bananas in Frankfort with other buying clubs in neighboring communities.

The next speaker was a farmer, Curtis Kirk, who observed that the farmer is the original environist. Environmentalists and farmers are really not that far apart. There are 761 farms in Franklin County totalling 96,982 acres. the average farm size is 127 acres. The average farmer is 53 years old and 62% are part-time. Cash receipts from crops are \$13,289 with live stock \$7,677 for a total average farm income of \$20,966. Burley

is the largest crop which is 83% of total farm income. The farmers of the future will be more diverse and complex. Farmers need to be more active in the political process to shape and control their own future. Policymakers are looking for more input from farmers. Although there are changing times these are also more challenging times. New jobs in agriculture are constantly cropping up.

In responding to questions from the floor, he stated that farm subsidies provide a cheap source of food for consumers and if subsidies are cut consumers should share in this. Also there may be a role for hemp in Kentucky's agricultural future.
