#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speaker, Byron Crawford of the Courier-Journal, is a favorite of our club, having spoken many times before. One of Kentucky's outstanding journalists, he has won a "Muddy Shoes" award for his work in the field. Born and raised in Kentucky, he is also a published author of books about life in Kentucky. Byron told a fascinating true story about how a friend's mother was able, many years ago, to afford to leave home in eastern Kentucky to go away to high school and college, because an older brother sold his prized saddle horse. If we ourselves think back, probably all of us "owe somebody a horse". He also told of the man on his death bed reviewing all the problems of his life, including losing a business, the depression, a house burning down, and countless other trials, and how his wife had stayed with him through it all, and finally summed it up by saying, "Ethyl, you're just bad luck for me!". Then he gave a brief sketch of many of the characters who have lived in Kentucky, including the constable who didn't have a drivers license, so he hitch-hiked. One day he caught a ride to E-Town, and gave his driver a speeding ticket when his ride was over. Other times, people would see him by the side of the road with his thumb out, a prisoner hand-cuffed to his other wrist.



#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our guest speaker at Rotary on June 14, 1995 was Frankfort's own Mary June Parks, renown author and lecturer on Bible based healthful living. Mrs. Parks' information and witty delivery delighted all in attendance. Following her presentation, many members were inquiring about specific topics, including her six books. To become more knowledgable in the benefits of healthful cooking, laughter and clean living, we need to read the books; practicing the principles, according to Mrs. Parks, would no doubt yield results.

Mrs. Parks discussed three factors that greatly affect our health: the environment, our water, and our food. We have little control over our environment, except avoidance of certain things or places. We would benefit from an air purifier. We should use non-chemical items such as white vinegar for \* cleaning; use cornstarch for perspiration; avoid cosmetics as they contain aluminum and wear natural fiber clothing. Also to be avoided are CRTs, microwaves, video games and lightbulbs. There are vitamin supplements that can be taken to combat ill effects of these things which are extremely hard to avoid Continued.... in today's society. As the water quality in our country is less than desirable, we should filter all water coming into our homes and filter our drinking water twice.

We are reminded that medicine doesn't cure everything, encouraged to be responsible for our own health, and to give heed to proper exercise and diet. Mrs. Parks walks one mile and bicycles five miles a day. She does this to increase circulation and rid her body of toxins. The diet she supports is one of nuts, seeds, grains, fresh fruit and

fresh vegetables. One must serve a combination of nuts, seeds, and grains in order to have a complete protein. An example is pinto beans and cornbread. Fresh fruit and fresh vegetables should not be served during the same meal.

Mrs. Parks advocates following the 11th Chapter of Leviticus regarding foods to eat and not to eat. She specifically mentioned abstention from pork, hardshell seafood and catfish. Other "no-nos" include shite flour. sugar and salt.




