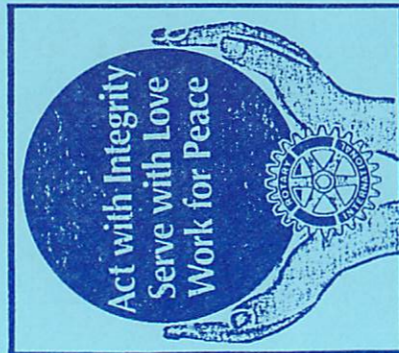

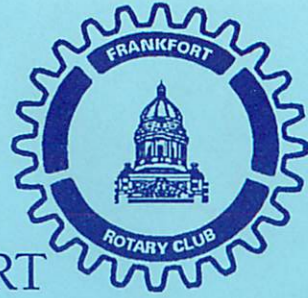

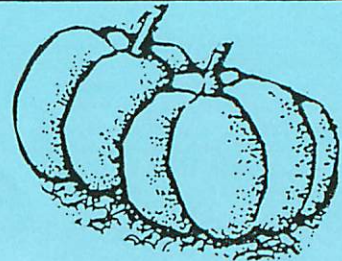

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker was Dr. Mary Smith, the eleventh President of Kentucky State University. She has been with KSU since 1970. Dr. Smith is an outspoken advocate of the value of education - believing that KSU is preparing students for learning throughout their lifetimes. Nearly 50% of this years students come from Franklin County and the five surrounding counties. The KSU Academic Team ranked 3rd out of 64 universities in a recent competition. Enrollment of students is up, and enrollment of international students has doubled. Students need to be exposed to other students from around the world. Dr. Smith also wants the Education and Nursing students to be more involved in the local community. The most important asset we have in this country is the higher education of our young people. The priority of higher education in state and local government has fallen in Kentucky and in 16 southern states. Total government funding of universities in Kentucky has fallen 17% in the past ten years, putting more of a burden on students and their families (and scholarship requirements).

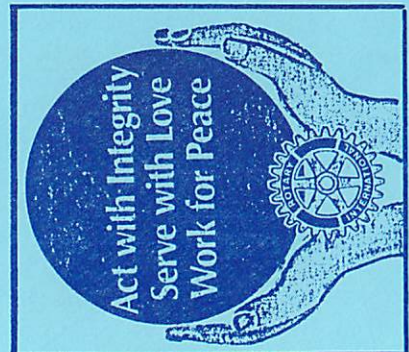

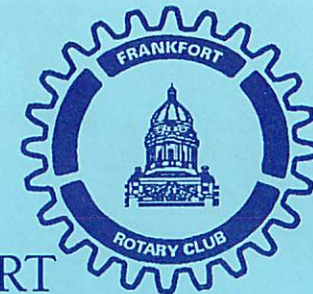

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was former Governor Wallace Wilkinson. Concerning the political scene in American today, he stated that if you complain enough, you will get on the Oprah show, if you keep complaining, Congress will give you money, and if you continue to complain, the president will make a speech and feel your pain. He wrote a book entitled "You Can't Do That Governor." He wrote the book because people need to understand how to make fundamental changes in their government. A book needed to be written by someone who was actually there. The book is about challenging the status quo and breaking down institutional barriers. When during the first few months of his administration, he had trouble getting things done, he knew he would have to be content changing what he could. He made progress when he demanded solutions from his appointees. Unfortunately, government is run by committees which seek to enlarge their staffs and perpetuate their existence. It is an arduous task to make fundamental changes. All his life, people have told him he can't do something or other. They were proved wrong. He decided that he would not throw money at problems but would spend money for solutions like KERA. Governor Wilkinson supports Paul Patton because at stake here is education reform and economic development. Forgy wants to destroy KERA and wants to go backwards. KERA is Kentucky's chance to be first for a change. Concerning higher education, there is a need for reform here. Increasingly, most parents cannot afford to send their children to Kentucky institutions for higher education.

Less than one half of students graduate from college. 50% of all professors don't teach and yet tuition keeps rising. TA's are teaching undergraduate courses and the average student takes seven years to get an undergraduate degree. Paul Patton again is the right choice for higher education reform. He asks us to read his book and find out what really went on in the Wilkinson administration.

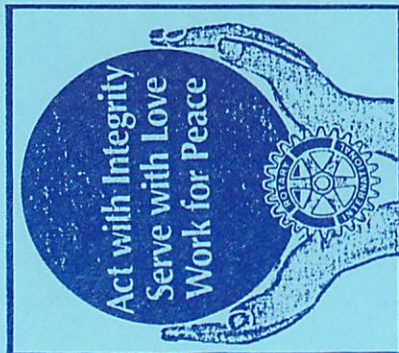

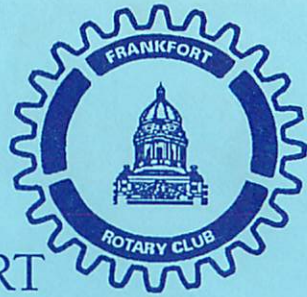

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Dr. Charles H. Bennett, a professor at Kentucky State University and a member of the Board of Regents. He spoke about his experience on the Apollo program and Apollo 13 in particular which will be very familiar to those who have seen the movie Apollo 13. The movie was very accurate. Although the mission was heavily associated with the number 13, the astronauts preferred the Italian interpretation which is that the number means good luck. One prime crew member was taken out because of his exposure to the German measles. On April 13, 1972 at 9:07PM an oxygen tank exploded inside the service module. Thousands of engineers contributed to the rescue mission which was thought to be impossible. The space craft was put into a 60 mile orbit around the moon and the astronauts were in the LEM three days. Power was drastically cut to the LEM to save on the consumables. The crew used the gear for the intended moon walk to keep warm in the LEM where the temperature was 39 degrees. The carbon dioxide level was increased so that the crew had to put together a carbon dioxide scrubber from materials on board. The story has a happy ending which culminated in a successful splashdown in the Pacific Ocean.

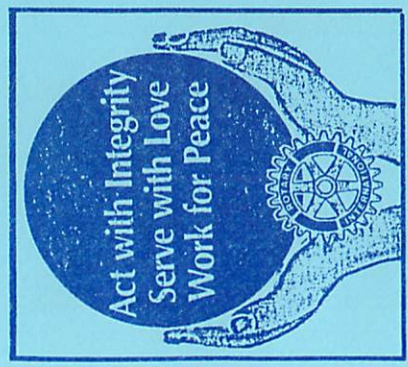

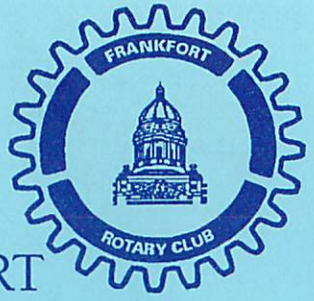
