#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was

Elizabeth Marshall who is Director of Governmental Relations for the Kentucky School Board Association. Public education affects our property values and our whole quality of life. We all have an interest in education. The number one concern today in our schools is safety, order and discipline. The Kentucky School Board Association helps school districts address these problems. In 1996, the General Assembly will be asked to open up the confidentiality protections for juveniles who commit violent offenses. Teachers and administrators have a right to know who these offenders are. We are concerned about the welfare of the law-aviding students. There is a need to know who the serious offenders are. The problem is that we are educating students who were not in the schools 15-20 years ago. Some of these students need specialized services since they are emotionally disturbed. Additional funding is needed. 39% to 50% of new money is used to keep these students in the mainstream of public education. State government has a strong role in public education. Parents now have a formal role in school councils under KERA. 70% of taxpavers today do not have children in the public schools. Things like partiotism and respect for others are taught there. Local boards have little control over what happens in schools. There is little discretion there on how funds will be spent. Local school boards should be albe to set minimum standards. This issue will be addressed in the upcoming General Assembly. In responding to questions from

#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Paul Ray Branham, C.P.A. who spoke about several proposed bills in Congress which will greatly simplify the federal tax code. There are three proposals to impose a flat rate tax. The first would set a flat tax rate of 17% which would be a tax only on earned income. No home mortgage interests or charitable deductions would be allowed. The second proposal would be a single tax rate of 20% only on earned income. The deductions for charities and home mortgages would not be eliminated. The third proposal would be a modified flat tax on both earned and unearned income. The rate would be 10% up to \$40,000 and 20% from \$40,000 to \$97,000 and on up.

Under the Archer plan, a national sales tax would be imposed on goods and services. This plan would also abolish the Internal Revenue Service. The Lugar plan calls for a 17% national sales tax. Critics say that such a tax would be very regressive. In order to save on taxes, year end tax planning should be done all year long. One should report income when the tax rate is at its lowest. In order to reduce your tax bill, postpone taxes whenever you can.
