THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Frank C. Miller, M.D. who is Hub's son-in-law and a faculty member at the U.K. Mediacl School. He spoke about the state of health care today particulary as it affects women. 60% of first year residents are women today. There are 126 medical schools in the U.S. which graduate 1100 residents in gynecology each year. the U.S. has the best health care in the world but we had a better infrastructure in health care delivery in the forties. The AMA and AAMC (American Association of Medical Colleges) try to establish manpower needs in terms of specialization. There needs to be more of a focus on primary care today. This nation graduates 12,000 doctors a year. Cities rely on residents for the care of indigents. Women's health care is in a transition. Earlier medical studies included only men. In 1990, an Office of Women's Health was formed. It was discovered that heart disease and hypertension was the number one killer of women. Since women outlive men by seven years, we want to assure they are healthy, productive years. Unfortunately, the mortality rate for breast cancer has stayed about the same because therapy has not caught up with diagnosis. Lung cancer has surpassed breast cancer as a killer. Women are also more susceptible to depression. Comestic violence against women is greater than ever suspected. There are more animal shelters than shelters for battered women. The curriculum of medical schools for hea-1th care for women is being emphasized.

GREETING NEW MEMBERS

Have you made an effort to meet our new members? Making new people feel at home goes a long way toward helping them become productive Rotarians.

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Ron Tyrer who is the hospital administrator for Bluegrass Medical Center. His talk was divided into three parts: Health Care Reform, trends in managed health care and changes in your local hospital. Under health care reform, the Health Policy Board was abolished and its functions transferred to Human Resources. Senate Bill 343 preserved the Health Purchasing Alliance. Also preserved was Kentucky Kare for state employees and renewability features. Senate Bill 343 dealt primarily with insurance reform. Concerning recent trends in managed care, the Health Maintenance Organizations use per diems where the hospital gets a fixed amount for a stay in the hospital. The drawbacks are that the most expenses are incurred the first few days with expenses such as surgery. In 1983, Medicare changed the way it reimburses hospitals. Medicare pays a fixed amount according to the diagnosis. This is preferable to per diem. One result of HMO's is that more physicians are leaving specializations and going into primary care. Overall, managed care is working well with no increases in premiums the last two years. Finally, he spoke about changes in our local hospital which will change its name to Columbia Hospital of Frankfort. The hospital has had an increase in patients by about 6% but the average monthly stay actually went down. Four days is now the average. The number of patients on a given day is down. The Hospital now has centralized transports which frees the nurses to tend more to patients. There is also, an increased use of computers by doctors and staff. The patient can be followed

on a daily basis at home. The hospital also has been engaged in downsizing.

In responding to questions from the floor Ron made the following observaitons. (1) There is a high turnover among RNs. (2) His job is harder today than it was when he became administrator in 1977. However, the work has also become more interesting.



THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was John P. Stevenson who spoke on behalf of the Kentucky Cattlemen's Association about the cattle industry. The Association has some four thousand members. There are 1.2 million mother beef cows with the average producer having about 25 head. 97% of beef which is the result of genetics. Cows are more lean with less fat today. Today the average beef cow weighs 550 pounds. The United States has 25% of the beef with 10% of the cattle. People eat less beef than they think which is also less than the food group chart indicates in the maximum amount one should eat. The export markets for beef are increasing especially to Japan. The Japanese like grain feed beef. The problem for the cattleman is that the price of corn has doubled. Poultry, beef and pork all compete for the corn. The price for cattle has dropped in the meantime from one dollar per pound to 50 cents per pound. Beef raising families have been hit hard by these factors. Also, three packers monopolize the business and there could be some anit-trust violations here. In responding to questions from the floor, he stated that the drought out west has hurt the beef farmer. On the other hand, the high price of corn has been good for farmers.
