THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was April DeLuca who spoke about Downtown Frankfort, Inc. which was started in 1989 with a grant from a Downtown Revitalization Project Grant. Frankfort is the seat of three governments. As such, it is important to keep lines of communication open with all agencies of government. The Downtown Candlelight tour enhances Frankfort's cultural life for the community. April asked for support of all Rotarians as volunteers. Frankfort can be a dynamic center of culture with her organization providing connections with the community. In responding to questions from the floor, she made the following observations.

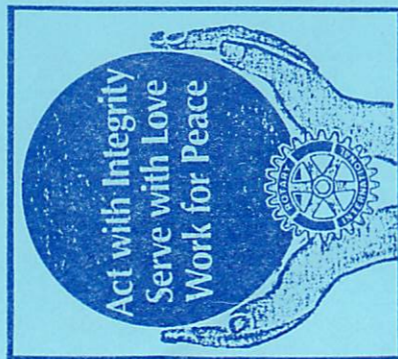

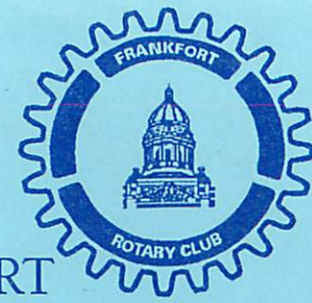

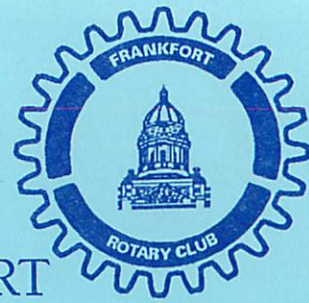

The speaker for the day was John Antenucci, president of Plan Graphics, Inc. His firm relates information on a map to other information like a video. It is like an index. There are three uses. 1.) manage a data base. 2.) Analytical purposes. An example would be to find the shortest pathway from point A to point B. 3.) Visualization tool to analyze data.

The data from his company is used in transportation planning and health services. It is used in the utility field like the Frankfort Plant Board. UPI is a client for vehicles and aircraft. Industries like banks use the service for locating branches and ATM's. If it has to do with geography, Plangraphics can do it.

They have worked with the largest cities, countries and corporations. They work with state governments and their Natural Resources Cabinets for example in the valuation of unmined minerals. Clients include the Kentucky River Authority and CSX to manage their property. The company has been international since 1980. The common denominator of all their work is geography.

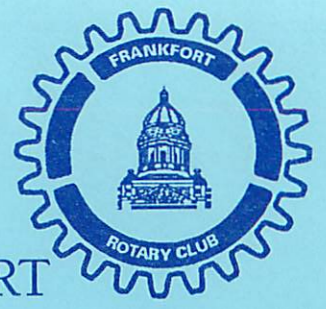

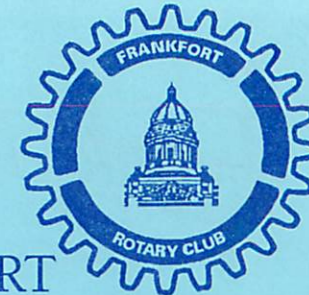
