The speaker for the day was April DeLuca who spoke about Downtown Frankfort, Inc. which was started in 1989 with a grant from a Downtown Revitalization Project Grant. 

The speaker for the day was John Antenucci, president of Plan Graphics, Inc. His firm relates information on a map to other information like a video. It is like an index. There are three uses. 1.) manage a data base. 2.) Analytical purposes. An example would be to find the shortest pathway from point A to point B. 3.) Visualization tool to analyze data.

The data from his company is used in transportation planning and health services. It is used in the utility field like the Frankfort Plant Board. UPI is a client for vehicles and aircraft. Industries like banks use the service for locating branches and ATM's. If it has to do with geography, Plangraphics can do it.


They have worked with the largest cities, countries and corporations. They work with state governments and their Natural Resources Cabinets for example in the valuation of unmined minerals. HOW ROTARY OPERATES

Rotary is organized at the club, district, and international levels to carry out its program of service around the globe. The key to keeping this vast international volunteer movement running smoothly is simplicity. Consider the gearwheel, the emblem of Rotary worn as a lapel pin that identifies Rotarians around the world. The gearwheel, with its 24 cogs, six spokes, and keyway, signifies that the Rotarian is a "worker" when it comes to serving others. Similarly, the gear-wheel symbolizes the essence of Rotary's structure as an organization. Each part of the Rotary movement is designed to interlink smoothly with the others, so that the whole runs to the maximum benefit of all. A Rotarian is a member of his or her Rotary club, and the club is a member of the association known as Rotary International. Each club elects its own officers and board of directors and enjoys considerable autonomy within the framework of its constitution and the RI Constitution and Bylaws.
