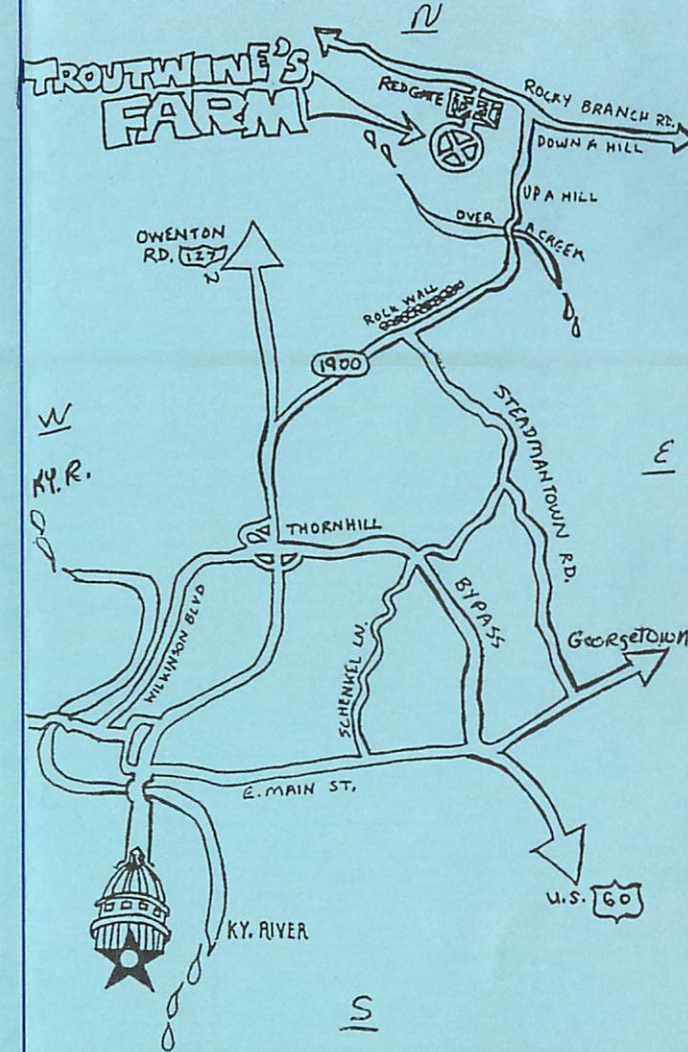

### KSU FRESHMAN WELCOMING

### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Speaker Dr. Jim Tidwell of KSU spoke on "Fish Farming in Kentucky: the KSU Aquaculture Research Program". Although fish are a healthy food, we only consume 15 lbs/person in the USA, down from 120 lbs/person in the Orient. (KSU is a Federal Land Grant College.) With an increasing demand (and a decreasing supply of natural fish, we need more aquafarming. Part of their research is developing nutritious feed, of which 40% of their feed mix is distillery grain. They are currently growing catfish in the summer (Warm water), and rainbow trout in the winter (Cold water) for a year-round growing season. Are trying to grow Paddle fish, a form of filter fish which is practically boneless. Also looking at "Cool water" fish for the spring and the fall growing season. One goal is fish with lots of meat and no brains, so they will bite on a bare hook at game farms. Another project is fresh water shrimp, as the USA consumes 2/3's of the worlds shrimp supply, with a large trade deficit. Trying out big-mouth bass, and Wall-eyes, which have a big demand in the mid-west. Hybred striped bass will be the next "catfish". A farmer needs about an acre pond to be feasible, at 1000 lbs of fish/acre, at a market of \$6.00 /lb. As the worlds oceans and rivers get more polluted, clean farm fish become more attractive to the consumer.

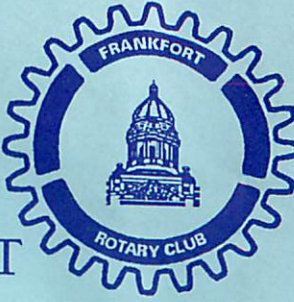

### ROTAFACT

The level of immunization of children against vaccine-preventable diseases in developing countries in the early 1990s ranged from 90 percent in East Asia and the Pacific to 50 percent in sub-Saharan Africa. During the past decade the figures have risen everywhere except in Eastern Europe, where the immunization rate declined from 88 percent to 77 percent.

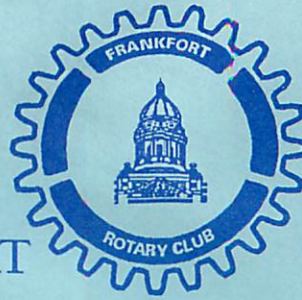
