#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Tom Webster, who is an entomologist at Kentucky State University who spoke about bee-keeping in the country of Ecuador. Kentucky is paired with one part of Ecuador and this is the most active partnership. Ecuador is free of internal strife as opposed to Colombia to the north and Peru to the south. It is also the number one exporter of bananas. There are three regions to Ecuador: the coastal region, the Andes mountains and the Amazon basin. Some ten million people live there on an area two and a half times the size of Kentucky. Tom heard about an interest in bees in Ecuador and in 1993 went to the Highlands region and in 1995 to the Amazon basin. He made numerous field trips to various bee-keeping operations in the countryside. Tom traveled around in the Amazon basin in a very large dug-out canoe. He put on a slide show which showed various aspects of bee-keeping operations including pollen traps.
