The speaker for the day was political commentator Al Smith. He stated there is no Democratic or Republican organization anymore in Kentucky. The Republican thread in Kentucky goes back to 1980 and the Reagan Revolution. This was accompanied by the death of Carol Perkins and the defeat of Huddleston. Former representatives Ward and Barlow were transitional figures. Kentucky has almost a total Republican delegation in Congress. The most significant thing which came out of this election is Patton's gamble on supporting Clinton in spite of considerable tobacco opposition. There is now an interesting alliance now between Gore and Patton. The main issues Clinton must deal with in the next four years are education, welfare, Medicare and reducing the deficit. 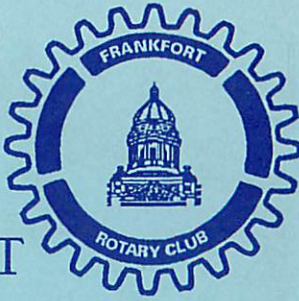

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Billy Ray Smith, Agriculture Commissioner. Agriculture is Kentucky's number one industry which is often taken for granted. It is a three and one-half billion economy in Kentucky which turns over six and one-half times in a community. Less than 2% of the population is directly involved which produces all the food supply in this country plus food for export. 24% of the employment in Kentucky is directly or indirectly related to agriculture. In spite of being such a big business here, agriculture has last year received less than one-third of one percent of the budget. Next year, this will increase to .40 of one-percent. Kentucky now has full funding of diagnostic operations and is the number one producer of live stock east of the Mississippi. An agriculture research center has been established at U.K. There is now regional funding at regional universities and additional funding for soil conservation programs. More money and time needs to be spent on marketing to make more people aware of agricultural needs. In this country, less than 10% of family income goes for food. It is much higher in many other countries. Turning to the Department of Agriculture, 68% of the agricultural budget goes to consumer protection. Examples of this are monitoring fuel prices and quality at service stations and the accuracy of scanners at super markets. They also check the safety of amusement rides, and regulate pesticides and chemicals used on farms. New programs of the Department are as follows: (1) The link

deposit program where some \$40 million in unclaimed property can be used as loans to farmers up to \$50,000. This will be handled through local banks. (2) Farm safety. Kentucky has three times the national average for farm injuries and deaths. Local organizations will bring attention to safety needs on the farm.. (3) He supports the fight against teen-age smoking. He is looking to additional uses for tobacco products. (4) Alfalfa hay program. (5) Develop new markets in the state of Kentucky products.

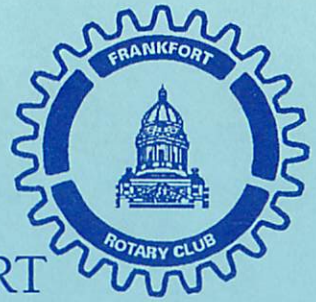

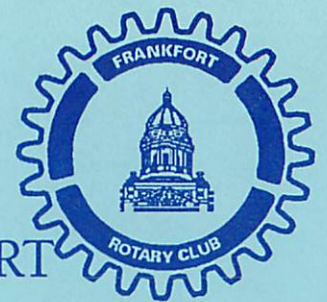

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speaker was the honorable Ben Chandler, Attorney General of the State of Kentucky, and the youngest in the nation. He talked about our justice system, and some of his concerns, such as fairness, and its lack of balance. He finds that people get angry when others do NOT play by the rules, and win. People are losing faith both in government, and the justice system. This needs to be reversed. He wants to hold public officials, and in fact, ALL people, accountable for their actings. For too long, we have worried about the rights of the criminals. He's trying to make a real push to address the rights of the victims. He gave us details of a case that has been on death row for 18 years -- a real abuse of the system. One forward step was a bill passed in the last legislature authorizing 22 new Commonwealth Attorneys (prosecutors). A Public Corruption Unit has been formed. DUI's are going to continue to be pushed. In closing, he stated that his almost 5 years in an elected office have been the most satisfactory years of his life, and he is going to keep on doing what he believes is right, regardless of the consequences. His grandfather told him that he can't make everyone happy, but he can try and earn their respect.

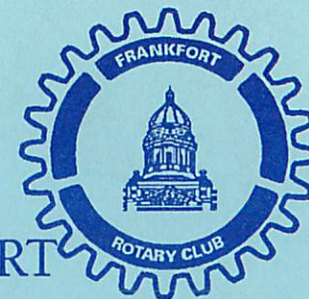
