THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speaker was our own Dr. Gary Straub, who will soon begin his 5th vear as Senior Minister at First Christian Church. His Doctorate is from Vanderbilt University in Pastoral Counseling. Being in the middle of the Christmas season, which began on St. VISA's day, the Friday after Thanksgiving (a high holy day with the area merchants), Gary asked us to sing with him a number of Christmas carols, accompanied by his faithful guiter. We were given a fascinating history of each carol sung. One dated back to at least the year 375 -- one by Charles Wesley, who wrote over 6500 hymns and carols -- one by a man who spent his entire pastorate in one church -- one written in the middle of the Mexican -American war -- One written after Gettysburg -- one written entirely in one evening (as were many of our greatest hymns). Interestingly enough, all were carols we all knew. He closed with a song about Christmas in Frankfort, set to the tune of "Silver Bells".
