\* The number of Interact clubs at the end of the 1996-96 Rotary year totalled 4,569, almost a 20 percent increase from a year earlier. Estimated membership was 105,000, a 25 percent increase from the previous year. Rotaract clubs numbered 5,759 and their estimated membership was 132,400, up 9 percent from last year.

\* The number of geographical areas in which there are Rotary clubs increased to 35 with the recent admission of the Rotary Club of Rovidenciales, Turks and Caicos Islands (District 7020, comprising Caribbean islands). The number of Rotary countries remains at 154.

#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Kay Harper of the Department of Environmental Protection. She spoke about "Empower Kentucky". The governor is driving this process. \$100 million has been devoted by the legislature for technolgy in state government. This will result ina \$50 million savings per year. They are looking at (1) How to change processes to make them better and (2) How to change technology in state government to make it better. There is much cooperation between the governor's office and cabinet and departmental heads. This means dealing with the people who do the job everyday. They are organized with teams in state government. Not all agencies are being looked at to change. They arelooking at how to mange materials in state government more efficiently. The key is to communicate between the teams.

## THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speaker was Dr. Desmund Layne from KSU, who spoke on his research in developing the Paw-Paw tree into a new fruit cash crop. It is sometimes called the "Poor Man's Banana", and tastes like a combination of a banana, mangrove, and pineapple. The tree grows in a temperate climate, and is native to 26 eastern states. In hardwood forests, it grows as a bush, and patches can cover an acre or more. In sunlight, it grows as a tree. The Paw-Paw is the largest gruit native to North America. Desoto wrote about them in 1541, and Daniel Boone and Mark Twain wrote about them in later years. Last year, he fielded over 2,000 requests for information about his research, both from this country, and around the world. The hope is that the Paw-Paw can become a cash crop for Kentucky farmers. Purdue University is doing research on an anticancer drug, especially ovarian, prostate, and pancreatic cancers. It can also be used as an organic pesticide. Will this be the next Kiwi storv?
