#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speakers were Ken Bates, Natural Resources, and Susan Carson Lambert from GIS. In 1994,a 25 person Geographic Information Advisory Board was created (of which Steve Dooley is a member), to develop and coordinate statewide geographic information resources. They are now developing a Base Map as a common background for all future activities, as well as doing some pilot studies in the Kentucky River Basin. We saw some satellite photos with a resolution of 1"=200'. As they gather the date, they will be looking for practical uses, such as blinking billboards, as well as public domain data bases. Also showed entering a name, and getting a map of where that person lived. (The test name of a real Rotarian showed 2 locations -- still waiting for an explanation.) Another use, through satellites, is looking at weather conditions world wide in real-time (in Berlin the resolution is so good that you can see people). McDonalds is using the demogrphic datato find new locations (where lots of kids live). ## MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Did you know that only three exceptions are made to the general classification rule that only one individual may hold the unique classification of a major "recognized activity" of a "firm, company, or institution." These three exceptions are: News media, religion, and diplomatic service. For example, we have several ministers in our club, and we can have more.

#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speaker was Steve Lenarz, Commissioner of Tax Collections, Kentucky Revenue Cabinet. He talked to us about where his department has been -and is going. There are three types of taxpayers: those who consistently and accurately comply; those who "try"; and those who simply don't -- and his department doesn't know in which type each of us fall, due to antiquated procedures (and computers). IRS estimates that 1 Of 20 Americans who should file a tax return -- don't. (Three people in the meeting?) To begin with, our tax laws are complex. They will be spending \$36.1 million to upgrade over the next sever1 years, and expect \$449 million in increased collections over the next 8 years. A big priority will be the ability to call up immediately everything on file for a given TIN. Problems are that 1/6th of the tax dollars collected are checked and recorded manually; 50 computers systems that don't talk to each other; computer programs written in the 1960's; misplaced records; and multiple phone transfers (avg 4-5).
