The Rotary Club of Ballard in Seattle, Washington, U.S.A., created 50 Paul Harris Fellows to celebrate its 50th anniversary, while the Rotary Club of Santos, Sao Paulo, Brazil, made 57 Paul Harris Fellows and one benefactor to honor member Paulo

#### THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was fellow Rotarians Richard Taylor, who spoke about the November 7, 1925 murder of the Kentucky Speaker of the House, Colonel Sharp, by a young lawver named Jerobam Beachamp. Sharp was killed by a stab wound in the chest. The case received national attention. Edgar Allen Poe wrote a poem about it and Robert Penn Wareen wrote a novel based on the murder call World Enough and Time. The best account of the murder was from Beachump's own confession. Beachamp's wife was an accomplice. Although the wife committed suicide in jail Beachamp was hanged at the Franklin County Health Center from a tree that stands to this day.



The dulcimer came to this country from Scandinavia following its origin in Central Europe, with the Hammered dulcimer coming into existence some 150 years ago.
