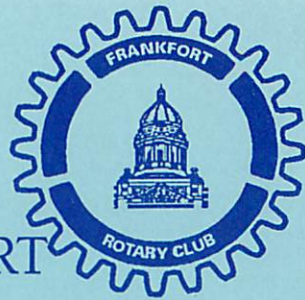

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Mike Mitchell who is head of Marketing One Securities at Farmers Bank. In 1981, we had a massive economic legislative package passed by Congress. We are looking at the same thing this year. As to Social Security, the money is not there presently for the baby boomers and we are looking at a \$12 trillion shortfall. When Social Security was enacted, there were 60 workers for every retiree. The ratio now is 3-1. Medicaid will soon be bankrupt as will as Medicare later down the road. Life expectancies are longer today. Mike listed several things to look for in legislation. (1) Capital gains reductions (2) gains to personal residences will be excluded (3) There will be various tax credits for child care, education, and estate tax will be modified. IRA regulations will be expanded (4) The social security age limit will be raised (5) Government spending will be cut (6) There will be more incentives to save and invest (7) Consideration will be given to the flat tax (8) Persons will be allowed to put some of their social security into the stock market (9) The way to figure the Consumer Price Index will be changed. Mike then spoke about the effect of this legislations on investments. As to short-term investments like CD's and bonds, they will continue to be good investments since the interest rate is above the inflation rate. However, the real wealth will be in the equity markets like stocks and real estate which are long-term investments. The growth in the stock market will continue and may even get better. We will see a greatly extended bull market in our lifetime.

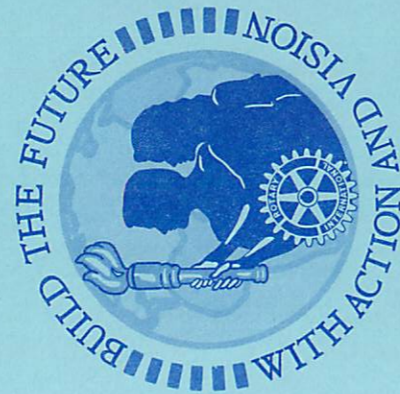

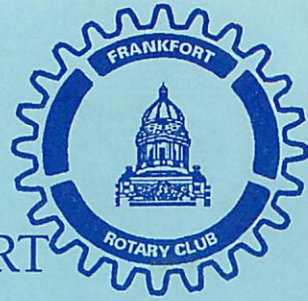

ROTARY BOARD MEETING

There will be a Board meeting on June 23, 1997 at the Frankfort Electric and Water Plant Board Office at 5:00 p.m.

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was fellow Rotarian Barry Holder, Sr. who is former occupational and health director for the state and now the Assistant Director for Labor and Training in the Labor Cabinet. Kentucky was the first state to be approved for supervising its own safety and occupational health program. They do not regulate things like mining and airplanes but do regulate may other areas including state employee. His agency oversees both the public and private sectors. In 1991, Congress increased the fines by seven fold and as a result more fines are being contested - 12% last year. Both small and big companies are regulated. There are four branches to his department. (1) The Safety Brach which teaches classes (2) The Health Branch which includes industrial hygenists who have to be board certified (3) The statistical services branch (4) The technical assistance branch. Although companies now have the right to insist upon a search warrant to inspect their property, Kentucky has a refusal rate of less than one percent which is the lowest in the country.

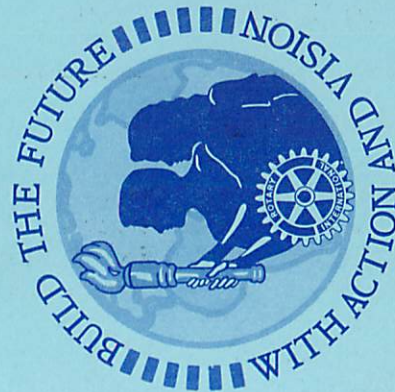

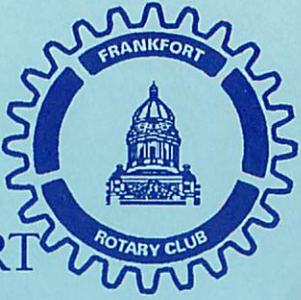

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Douglas McMeechin who lived in the Amazon region of Ecuador for 11 years. He worked with the indigenous Indians there. Ecuador is about the size of Colorado and Quito is the capital. He worked on a UNICEF educaitional project. Some 30 Indian communities were involved. There are no roads to the area which is accessible only by canoe. Their way of learning is to see and participate. The goal was to introduce alternative methods of education and bring the communities together to work together. Health is the single most pressing need. Clinic projects were begun and people came together for a common goal. He also worked in the area of agriculture. Raising cattle is the most prestiguous occupation but it is very destructive of the rain forests. New crops were introduced on a small scale and every thing is done by hand. One method of introducing alternatives is to help women generate a source of income such as a bee-keeping project to produce honey.

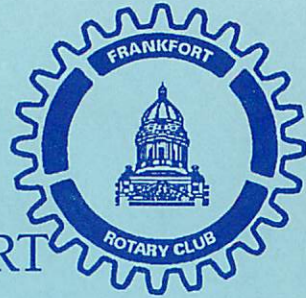
