THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for the day was District Governor Jerry Parker who talked about the theme of Rotary. As he gazed at the various flags at the Rotary International conference in Glasgow, Scotland, he thought about the possibility of peace among all nations. Peace is a state of mind and is the most sought after treasure. World peace and understanding is the ultimate goal of Rotary. From the world family of nations comes the world family of people. However, there will never be peace until hunger and poverty are eliminated. The single challenge for Rotary is to chart a course that will address the problems of people like PolioPlus. This program put Rotary on the world stage. World-wide respect has come from this. The problem of the distribution of food confounds the experts. Rotary projects influence others to eradicate hunger and achieve peace. This can be done through Rotary Foundation programs which fund food pantries and soup kitchens. Another important goal is to teach people to read and write. 900 million people are illiterate in the world and millions of others are functionally illiterate. Through comprehensive education we can teach people to read and write and work with numbers. Many are denied advantages that were given to us. The Rotary Foundation works here also. Rotary must fulfill its destiny to promote peace. This is achieved through eliminating hunger and illiteracy. The expertise to do this is within Rotary's ranks and this will improve the quality of life around the world. We must use Rotary to improve the common good of all. Rotarians must be leaders in their jobs.

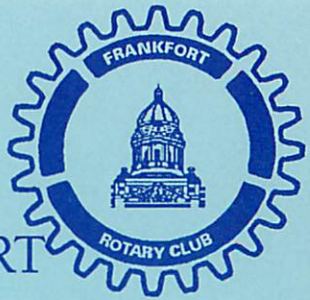

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our Speakers were members of Frankfort's Sister Cities visitation team to San Pedro de Macoris in the Republic of Dominica last April: fellow Rotarians Lee Troutwine, Jim Richardson, and Bill Leroy; and Frankfort H.S. Spanish teacher Michelle Coomer.

Charlie Hinds gave a long and glowing introduction of Lee, who then spoke a bit about the objectives of the visitation team. Michelle, the unofficial interpreter, spoke on the 8 days of long all day tours, and especially the schools she visited, outlining some of the differences between the private and the public schools, and then told us details of a planned visit by 21 of her students there next spring. Jim spoke on the local economy -- they are the largest American market in the Caribbean, the largest telecommunication market in Latin America - all wireless- by GTE, Canada. Their next major project will be the state national health program, with the building of more than 20 new hospitals. Having run out of time, Bill only spoke on the university they visited, and the number of teenagers who spoke English, and then translated for their parents.

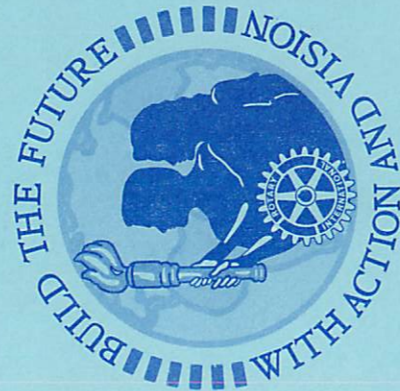

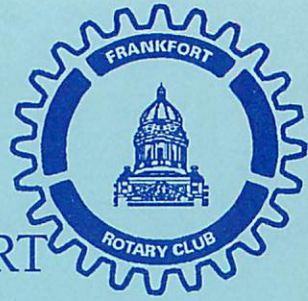

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

Our speaker was Kentucky State Senator Fred Bradley, a native of Providence, KY -- a farmer, raises horses, runs a trucking company, and is the Senate Majority Whip. Fred spoke to us about Higher Education, among other topics.

Unemployment is way down, many types of special taxes are down or gone. He is finding more and more that Kentuckians need more than a high school education to compete in today's job market. He is a great believer in the community college system. Fred has served under 5 governors, and the current one is working hard to communicate with the legislature. In the special session, the legislature worked pretty well together.

Health care -- Premiums are high. We need a set of national rules. If Kentucky comes up with a good plan, people in bad health will move to Kentucky to be a part of this plan. We need a better insurance premium rate structure, equitable between young and old. It is not that the legislature or insurance companies are wrong - but that we are living longer, and demanding better health care.

Budget - it is hard to prepare today a realistic budget of income and expenses, to go into effect in July of 1998, and last 24 months to July of 2000.

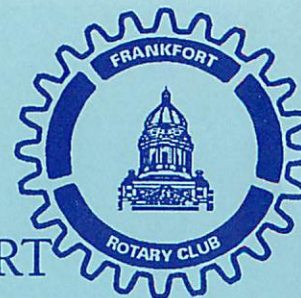

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speaker for the day was Ron Crouch who spoke on the demographics of competitiveness. He stated that perceptions change but reality does not. He supports critical thinking skills as promoted by KLRA. Secondly, we must look at trends. That is, what is happening over time. For example, the perception is that crime is increasing when in fact crime is substantially decreasing. Thirdly, we must look to magnitude and what are the real issues. Finally, we must see the big picture. Today, we know more and more about less and less. For example the perception is that in southern states, we are barefoot and pregnant. In fact, the birth rate is drastically decreasing in all southern states except Georgia and Florida. There are fewer kids in Kentucky today and thus fewer persons at the entry level age as far as employment is concerned. There are far fewer people today who are in their youth particularly in eastern Kentucky. The old barefoot and pregnant perception is not realistic. His final advice is "do not retire." With the baby boom aging as it is, retirement is no longer affordable.

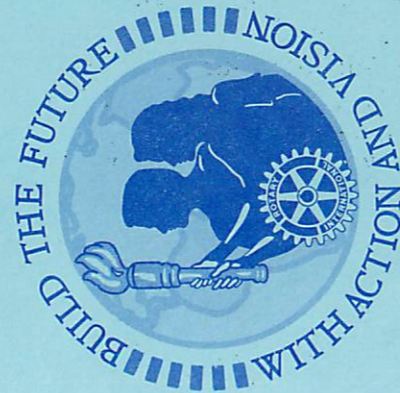

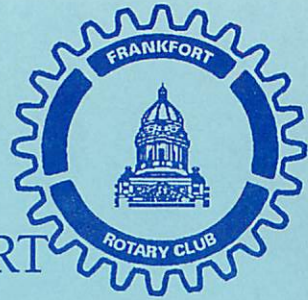

THIS WEEK'S SPEAKER

The speakers for the day were David Sandidge and John Higgenbotham with the Frankfort Plant Board. Pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, a full service network is contemplated for Frankfort. A feasibility study has been done which includes: (1) Financing (2) Get a second opinion of the study (3) Community support (4) A double check of all figures. An initial survey shows that 83% of subscribers said the Network should proceed. The Full Service Network means the following: (1) About 24 more television channels (2) Pay per view (3) Expanded basic which means more choices and options (4) High Definition TV (5) Security for homes and businesses (6) Telephone services. Telecommunications companies have spent billions on the Sonet Standard. This is what gets the signal to your home. It will be done in three phases. Phase I will cover the downtown section which needs the most work. Each phase will take one year. Phase II will cover the east part of town. Phase III will cover the West part of town. The benefits of the Full Service Network are as follows: (1) Cable TV (2) Pay Per View (3) Expanded basis (4) High Definition TV which will mean better picture quality and more reliable service (5) Residential phone service which will mean a savings of \$3.00 to \$5.00 per month. (6) Business phone service which will mean a 15% savings (7) Security services for home and business will be locally monitored. This will also detect tampering (8) High capacity private network services (9) Connect multiple facilities (10) Better customer convenience and satisfaction.

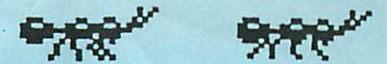

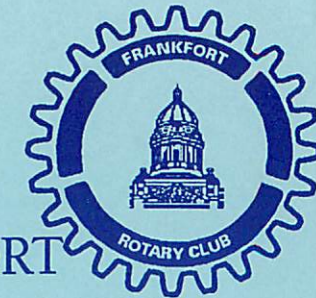
