

#### CLASSIFICATIONS

The classification principle of membership distinguishes Rotary from all other organizations. By accepting the loan of a classification, each Rotarian assumes an obligation to represent his business or profession in the club and to share the ideal of service with non-Rotarians associated in the workplace. It assures a membership which is representative of the business, professional and institutional life of the locality in which the club is established.

CLASSIFICATION - The principal and recognized activity of a firm, company, institution, business or professional endeavor.

Classifications are determined by the activity or service to society rather than the position held by the individual. In other words, if president of a bank, a person is not classified under "Bank President" but under the classification of "Banking", or that person may be loaned the classification of the activity he or she is principally engaged in.

To be eligible for a specific classification, the proposed member should be generally recognized in the community as being primarily engaged in that business, profession or activity. In the fields of medicine, dentistry, law, etc. where specialization in a given field is recognized by a community, it is appropriate for the Rotary Club to establish and loan separate classifications to cover such specialized practices.

The Board of Directors of Rotary Clubs should annually update the listing of classifications in their community, showing the names of members and their classifications and the unfilled classifications that are open for membership. Rotary International publishes a list of classifications in a typical community, but clubs are urged to add to this listing and establish whatever classifications are needed in their area.

Balanced Membership: efforts should be made to maintain a well balanced membership in which no business or professional group predominates - allowing a club's membership to be representative of the business and professional life of the community.





#### Minutes of the June Board of Directors Meeting

Frankfort Electric Plant Board 5 p.m. Monday, June 15, 1998

Attending: Don Armstrong, Clay Hulette, Tom Utterback, Paula Rarden, Terry Shockley Ron Tyrer; Absent excused: Polly Green, Ed Dance, Mary Vaughn and Dave Weller; absent unexcused Perry Ryan and Laura Graham.

1. Announcements included a discussion of a proposal to cancel the last meeting of June, ich was not approved. Those attending

the International Dinner may claim meeting credit or makeup within the two-week period.

- 2. Minutes were approved for the May 18 Board of Directors meeting as presented by executive secretary Paula Rarden and published in the Frankfortarian. The Financial Report was approved for May 1998 by Clay Hulette, including authorization for payment of the fee for the Little League Rotary baseball team, an expected but unbudgeted expenditure. The June Attendance Report compiled by Ethel McCray was accepted with the sincere appreciation of the Board for her faithful work every week. Another matter was explained concerning the publication schedule of the Frankfortarian Newsletter, including the assurance from Troy Dix that missing back issues would be reprinted and mailed at the Frankfort Post Office, prepared weekly by Advisory Director Dave Weller.
- 3. Old Business: The installation of new officers for 1998-99 on Wednesday, July 1, will be conducted by incoming District Governor Tom Diener of Louisville, who will make his official club visit on that date. The board approved the appointment by President Armstrong of Pete Walsh to Frankfort Rotary Youth Fund Board to replace Tim Fyffe for the remaining two years of his term.
- 4. New Business: A revised list of club monthly program chairs for 1998-99 provided by Jim Graves will be printed in the Frankfortarian. The board approved expenses for preparing awards for distinguished service during the 1997-98 club year, to be presented Wednesday, June 24, by President Don Armstrong. Ron Tyrer, international service director, reported there are 53 Rotarians and spouses planning to attend the International Dinner which is being arranged by Charlie Hinds, although he needs information from the Capitol City Club.
- 5. The Board approved the new membership application of Arthur L. Kelly, retired U.S. Army colonel and published author, sponsored by Len Shirrell. This information is published for the

required two-week comment period as of Wednesday, June 17. Leaves of Absence were approved as requested by Ann Maenza April 1 through Sept. 30 and by John Loyd July 1 through December 31. Resignations were received from Shirley Radford who has moved to Florida and by Ron Durham Jr. based on his request letter.

6. Other business included a general discussion of committee appointments by incoming directors and the meeting with Gov. Diener scheduled the morning of Wednesday, July 1.

The next scheduled meeting will be held at the Electric Plant Board, 5 p.m. Monday, July 20, the first monthly meeting of 1998-99 Rotary Board of Directors under incoming President Ed Dance.




