From the new FRANKFORTARIAN Editor Bill Leroy

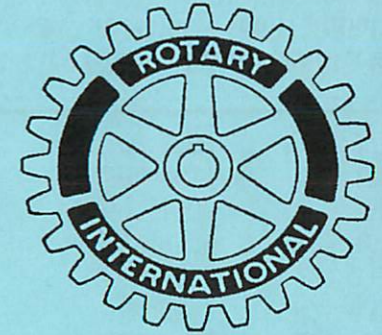
