SPOTLIGHT ON OUR DIRECTORS

In an attempt to achieve better communications between the Directors and the Club members as to 'just exactly what is going on' in our club, and in particular of planned activities for the next year (and as mentioned in an earlier issue of the Frankfortarian, and in the write-up of the July Board minutes), -- it was decided by the Board that in each of the August issues, we would highlight an Avenue of Service and its Director --and report to the Club that Directors plans for the year as delivered to our District Governor in the meeting with him the first of July, in sequence as follows: Club Service, Community Service, Vocational Service, International Service, and the Presidents recap.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION: The term "four Avenues of Service" is frequently used in Rotary literature and information. The "Avenues" refer to the four elements of the Object of Rotary: Club Service, Vocational Service, Community Service and International Service. Although the Avenues of Service are not found in any formal part of the constitutional documents of Rotary, the concept has been accepted as a means to describe the primary areas of Rotary activity.

"Club Service" involves all of the activities necessary for Rotarians to perform to make their club function successfully.

"Vocational Service" is a description of the opportunity each Rotarian has to represent the dignity and utility of one's vocation to the other members of the club.

"Community Service" pertains to those activities which Rotarians undertake to improve the quality of life in their community. It frequently involves assistance to youth, the aged, handicapped and others who look to Rotary as a source of hope for a better life.

The Fourth Avenue "International Service" describes the many programs and activities which Rotarians undertake to advance interna-

tional understanding, goodwill and peace. International Service projects are designed to meet humanitarian needs of people in many lands.

When a Rotarian understands and travels down the "Four Avenues of Service," the Object of Rotary takes on even greater meaning.

The Director of Club Service is Laura Graham, a long time and dedicated Rotarian, who has been responsible for a number of Areas of Service during recent years, serving with several different Presidents.

- 16.) Scheduled next board meeting for September 21, 1998 at First Federal Savings and Loan.



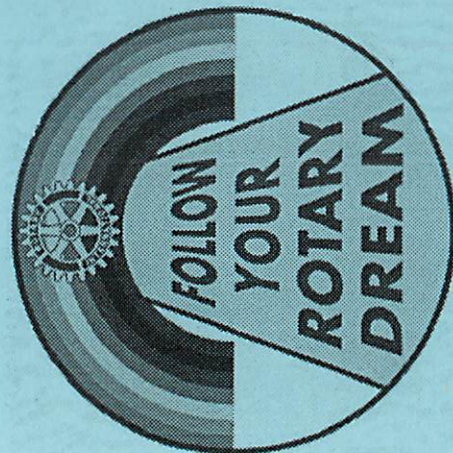
