Andrew Smith is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Music. He is in his first year as Director of the Opera Program at KSU and brings with him a great deal of knowledge and professional experience from the field of the performing arts.

He is a regular guest of America's leading opera companies, including the Metropolitan Opera, the New York City Opera, the Connecticut Opera, the Pittsburgh Opera, and the New Jersey State Opera.

In Europe, he was a featured soloist at a Command Performance at Kensington Palace in a benefit for the London City Ballet, and was featured soloist with the Mexico City Symphony. He has appeared with the Birmingham (England) Opera Festival, Opera Royal de Wallonie, and at Budapest, Hungary. He has also appeared with the orchestras of Atlanta, Cleveland, Chicago, Milwaukee, Louisville, and Buffalo.

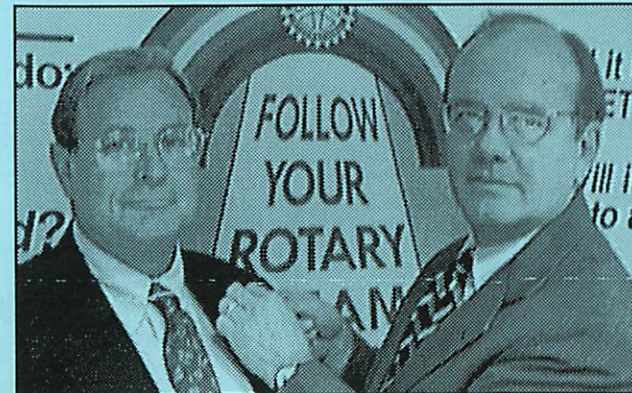
### SHARING ROTARY WITH NEW MEMBERS

An excerpt from the ABC's of Rotary by Past R.I. President Cliff Dockerman:

"Of all the obligations a person accepts when joining a Rotary club, the one in which most Rotarians fail is in sharing Rotary. The policies of Rotary International clearly affirm that every individual Rotarian has an obligation to share Rotary with others and help extend Rotary through proposing qualified persons for Rotary club membership."

- 11.) Scheduled next board meeting for November 25, 1998.



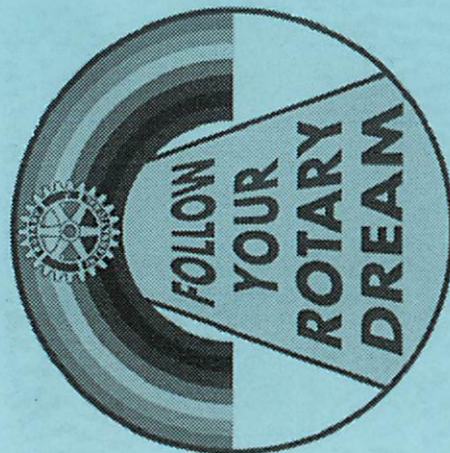

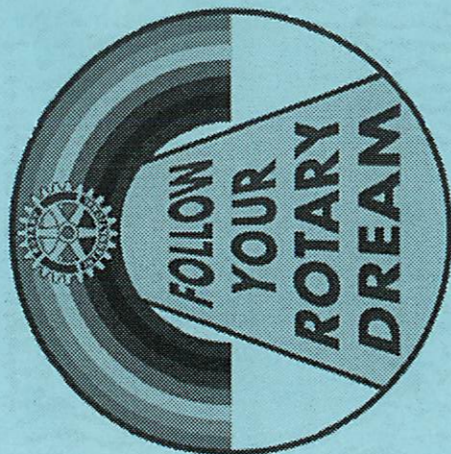
