**BY-LAWS OF THE
FRANKFORT ROTARY CLUB**

(Continued)

Article IV — Meetings

Section 1. The annual meeting of the club shall be held on the first Wednesday in December of each year, at which time the election of officers and directors to serve the ensuing year shall be held.

Section 2. The regular weekly meetings of this club shall be held on Wednesday at 11:45 a.m. at the Holiday Inn Capital Plaza, Frankfort, Kentucky. Due notice of any changes in or cancellation of the regular meeting shall be given to all members of the club. The time and place of the regular meeting may be changed from time to time by the board. Such changes shall constitute an amendment to these by-laws, notwithstanding any other provisions for amending these by-laws. All members excepting an honorary member (or member excused by the board of directors of this club, pursuant to article VII, section 3 of the standard Rotary constitution) in good standing in this club, on the day of the regular meeting, must be counted as present or absent, and attendance must be evidenced by the members being present for at least sixty (60) percent of the time devoted to the regular meeting, either at this club or any other Rotary club.

Section 3. One-third of the membership shall constitute a quorum at the annual and regular meetings of the club.

Section 4. Regular meetings of the board shall be held monthly at a time and place designated by the president at his/her discretion. Special meetings of the board shall be called by the president whenever deemed necessary, or upon the request of two members of the board, due notice having been given.

Section 5. A majority of the board members shall constitute a quorum of the board.

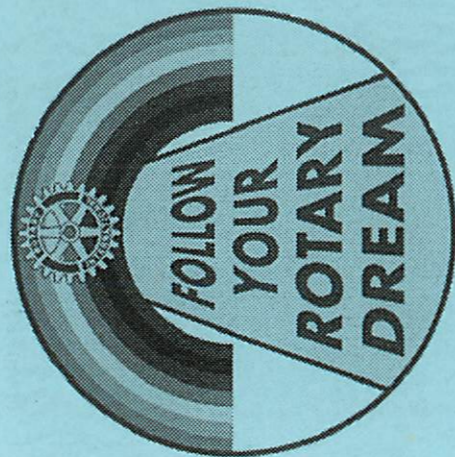

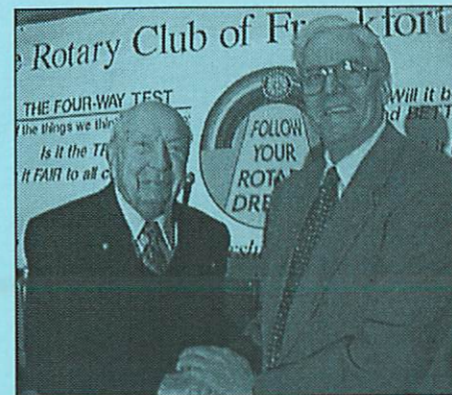
RICHARD TAYLOR IS KENTUCKY'S NEW POET LAUREATE

Special thanks to Director Terry Shockley, Mike Oder and David Herbert for arranging this trip and to Sherrill Smith for driving the bus and chaperoning.

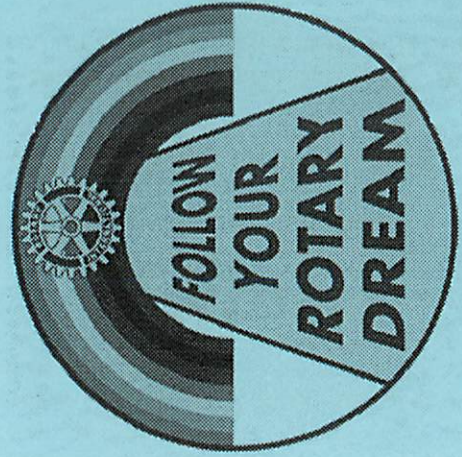

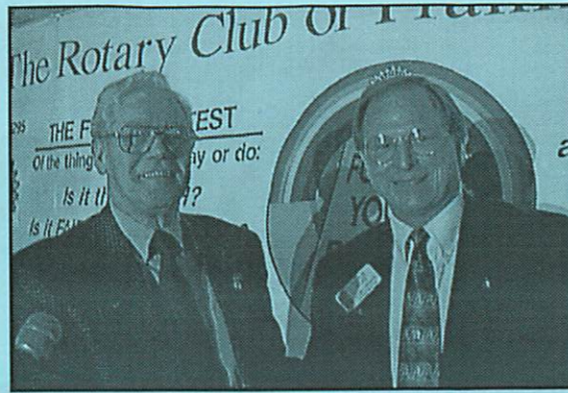

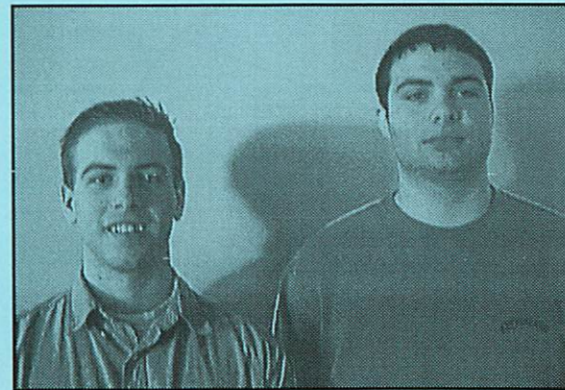

10. Make services to your church, your community or your country your greatest hobby. Look on retirement as a continuation of life and a time for greatness.

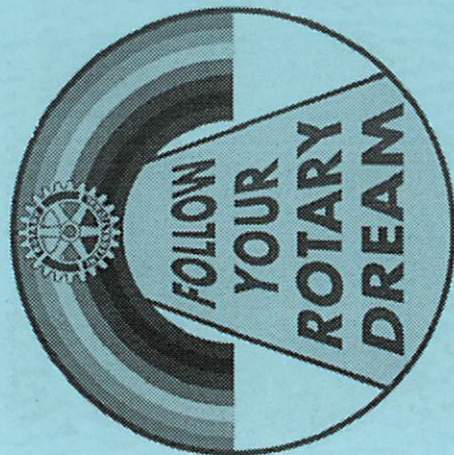

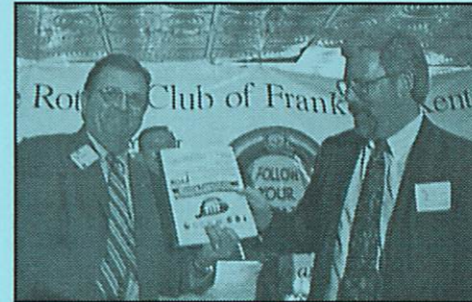

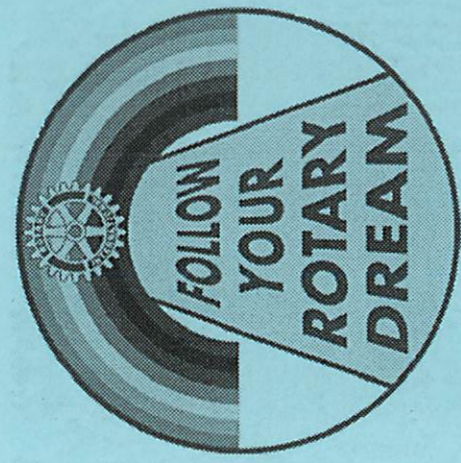
