Virginia Gaines Fox, our Rotary Club speaker for Wednesday, July 14, is the Executive Director of KET - The Kentucky Network.

She joined Kentucky Educational Television (KET) in 1968, and became its Deputy Executive Director in 1975. In 1980, Mrs. Fox left KET to become president

of the Southern Educational Communications Association. While at SECA, Mrs. Fox became the founding director of the Satellite Educational Resources Consortium, a provider of distance learning courses whose members include the KET Star Channels. She returned to KET in 1988 as Chief Operating Officer and was named Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer in 1991.

Mrs. Fox is an active Board member on a vast array of community service organizations. Leadership Kentucky; Public Broadcasting Service; United Way of Kentucky; University of Kentucky School of Journalism Board of Visitors; among others.

She received a Bachelor's Degree (with distinction) in elementary education from Morehead State University in 1961; and in 1969 a Master's Degree in Library Science from the University of Kentucky.

Remember these 31 words when someone asks, "What is a Rotary Club?"

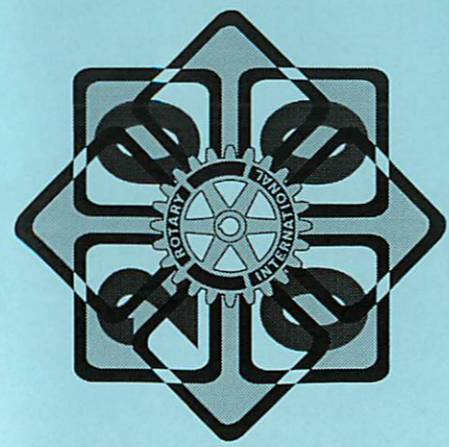

Next Week in Rotary...



Dr. Michael B. McCall, President of the Kentucky Community and Technical College System, will be the speaker at Frankfort Rotary on Wednesday, July 21. He will be introduced by Don Armstrong, program chair for the month of July.

Dr. McCall was appointed as the first president of the Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS) last Dec. 3, a position which makes him chief executive officer over 13 community colleges and 15 technical colleges in Kentucky which now make up KCTCS. He oversees a system that has an annual budget of nearly \$300 million and serves approximately 45,000 credit-seeking students. Dr. McCall reports to the 14-member KCTCS Board of Regents. KCTCS was created by the Kentucky Postsecondary Education Improvement Act of 1997.

In his first few months in Kentucky, Dr.

McCall has indicated that he will assess the status of Kentucky's community and technical colleges, build support for all of these colleges, and develop the knowledge to run the system as efficiently and effectively as possible.

Dr. McCall previously was executive director of South Carolina's two-year technical and community college system. He was the chief executive officer of 16 colleges and provided leadership for the state's economic development training programs. Dr. McCall also served as president of Florence Darlington Technical College in Florence, S.C., and as president of Paul D. Camp Community College in Franklin, Va.

He received his bachelor's degree in physics and mathematics from Wilmington College in Wilmington, N.C.; his master's in physics from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, Blacksburg, Va.; and his doctorate from VPI.

Dr. McCall's immediate family includes his wife, Carolyn; daughter Chandra, who works in engineering sales with Cutler-Hammer in Knoxville, Tenn.; son Michael, a junior at College of Charleston in Charleston, S.C.; and daughter Elizabeth, a senior in high school.
