*Next Week in Rotary...*

Status of Postsecondary Education in Kentucky presented by Dr. Gordon K. Davies, President of the Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education.

The Council was created by the Kentucky General Assembly in 1997 as part of a higher education reform effort initiated by Governor Paul Patton. Davies joined the Council in 1998 as its first president. He came to Kentucky with extensive experience in state higher education system coordination, having served from 1977 until 1997 as director of the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia.

Before coming to Kentucky, Davies was a visiting professor in the Department of Organization and Leadership at the Teachers College of Columbia University.

Davies' lengthy tenure in Virginia was marked by substantial enrollment growth in the state-supported colleges and universities, and by innovative program and funding initiatives that helped place Virginia in the forefront of American higher education. He was principal author of "The Case for Change," the report issued by Virginia's Commission on the University of the 21st Century (1989). The report drew national and

international attention, with presentations to representatives of about one dozen foreign countries and more than half the American states and territories.

Davies also has served as an officer in the U.S. Navy, has held marketing positions in the computing industry, was a founding dean of a new public college, and taught Religious Studies at Yale University. He has been a strong advocate for equal educational opportunity for 30 years, having directed the Harvard-Yale-Columbia Intensive Summer Studies Program from 1968 to 1971. The program offered educational enrichment to students from the nation's historically black colleges and universities, helping them prepare for graduate and professional study.

His degrees are from Yale University in English (B.A.) and Philosophy of Religion (M.A. and Ph.D.). He has been awarded six honorary degrees.

He has competed in more than two dozen marathons, including five at Boston, and has done rock climbing and mountaineering on four continents.

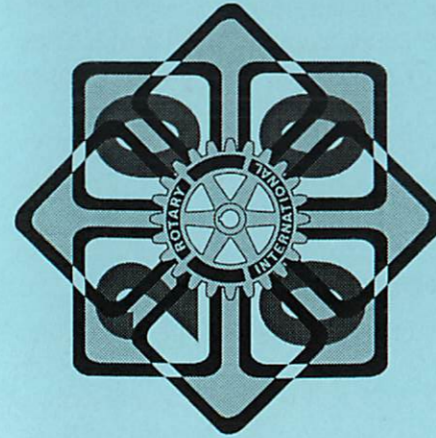

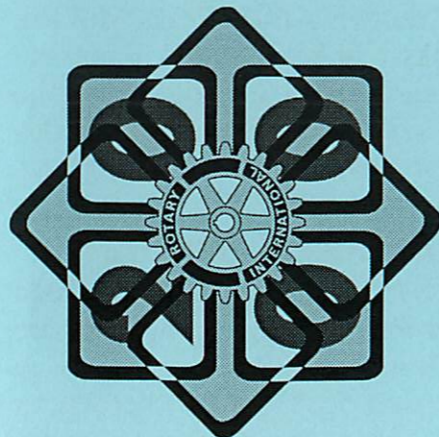

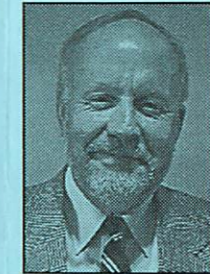

Dave loves to sing and is a member of a local church choir.

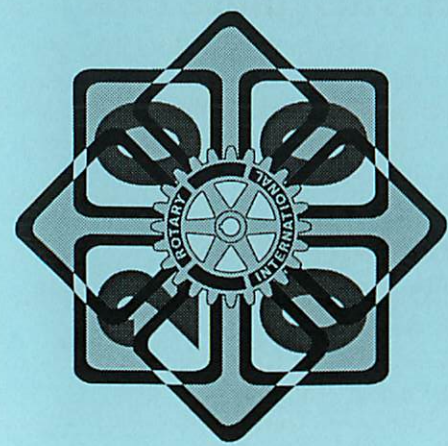

#### ERNIE FLETCHER

##### U.S. Congressman \* Ky. Sixth District Speaker at Frankfort Rotary Sept. 1



U. S. Rep. Ernie Fletcher, first elected to Congress in 1998 from Kentucky's 6th Congressional District, will be the speaker at Frankfort Rotary Club on Wednesday, Sept. 1, which meets at 11:45 a.m. at the Holiday Inn. He will be introduced by the September program chair, Jim Wolcott.

Congressman Fletcher is a member of both the House Budget Committee and Agriculture Committee and serves on the Committee on Education and the Workforce, where he is the vice-chairman of the subcommittee on employer-employee relations. In addition, Fletcher was elected as the freshman liaison to the Republican leadership of the House. His Congressional district includes Anderson, Bath, Bourbon, Boyle, Clark, Estill, Fayette, Franklin, Garrard, Harrison, Jessamine, part of Lincoln, Madison, Mercer, Montgomery, Nicholas,

Powell, Scott and Woodford.

Fletcher is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force where he was an F-4E Phantom Jet aircraft commander and as well as an alert force commander for the North American Air Defense Command. As an Air Force fighter pilot, Fletcher led flights that intercepted Soviet military aircraft during the cold war.

Rep. Fletcher began his public service as a state representative for the Kentucky 78th District. During his term in office he served on numerous committees, including the Kentucky Commission on Poverty and the Task Force on Higher Education. He also was chosen by the Governor to play a leadership role in reforming Kentucky's ailing health-care system.

Fletcher is a native Kentuckian and long-time resident of Lexington, born in 1952 at Mt. Sterling. Fletcher received a B.S. degree from the University of Kentucky College of Engineering in 1974 and earned the M.D. degree in 1984 from the University of Kentucky College of Medicine. He is married to his high school sweetheart, Glenna Foster. They have two grown children, Rachael and Benjamin and two grandchildren.

Rep. Fletcher was a family practice physician and CEO of the St. Joseph Medical Foundation. He has also served as a lay minister with the Porter Memorial Baptist Church.

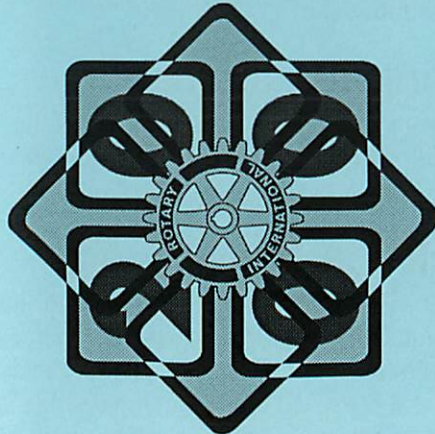
