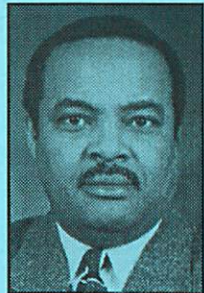

**Reginald S. Avery, Ph.D.**

**Kentucky State University  
Vice President for Academic Affairs**



Dr. Reginald S. Avery, who is Kentucky State University's Vice President for Academic Affairs, will be the program speaker at the Rotary Club of Frankfort on Wednesday, October 13. Dr. Avery will be introduced by October program chairman George W. Reid.

Avery will speak about initiatives in the KSU academic affairs area, especially the Program of Distinction and the rebuilding of the education program.

Dr. Avery was named in 1998 as Vice President for Academic Affairs at KSU, coming from Benedict College at Columbia, S.C., where he was dean of the School of Programs. He holds his doctorate from the Brandeis University School for Advanced Studies in Social Welfare, the Master's in social work from George

Williams College School of Social Work, and a B.S. degree from North Carolina A&T State University. Avery also has a certificate in Management Development from Harvard University granted in 1997.

At Kentucky State, Dr. Avery is responsible for administrative oversight for various units in the academic sector of the University. These include the College of Professional Studies, School of Business, School of Public Administration, the Whitney M. Young, Jr. College of Leadership Studies and the College of Arts and Sciences, as well as a number of other areas.

He also served as an associate professor of social work at the University of Tennessee from 1987-93. Avery taught in the Graduate School of Social Work at the University of Arkansas 1979-86. Before that he was a member of the faculties at the University of Massachusetts at Boston, Fitchburg State College (MA), Western Michigan University and the Southern Region Educational Board.

Dr. Avery has a long list of professional presentations at workshops and conferences, as well as a number of funded research grants and projects. He belongs to the NAACP and the National Urban League, and is active in professional organizations related to his social work expertise and academic credentials.

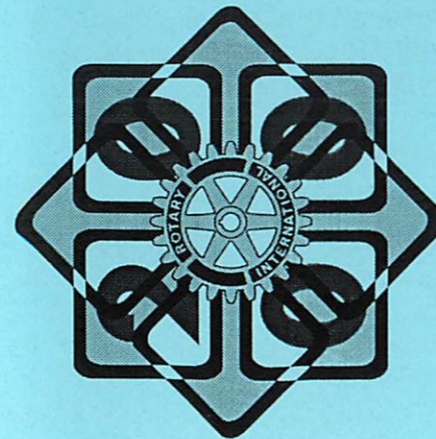

Hinfred McDuffie, vice president for university advancement at Kentucky State University, will be the speaker at the Rotary Club of Frankfort Wednesday, Oct. 20. He will be introduced by George W. Reid, program chair for October, and will speak on the role of recreating a positive image for KSU, including his

vision of KSU and the Frankfort community. McDuffie has more than 22 years experience in program administration for institutional advancement in higher education. This includes work in both annual campaigns and capital campaign development. He became vice president at KSU this year under President Reid. He had been executive director for development at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore at Princess Anne, MD, from 1993-99, where the development program raised over \$1.2 million annually.

He had served as a senior development officer at

the City College of New York for three years up to 1993. Before that, from 1977-90, McDuffie held similar positions at Alabama State University and earlier was employed at Tuskegee Institute at Tuskegee, AL, as minority business developer for a 21-county area of Alabama.

McDuffie holds two master's degrees from Alabama State at Montgomery and earned his BS in business management from Tuskegee Institute in 1971.

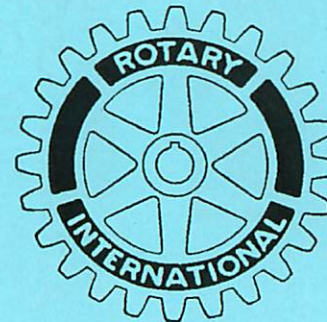

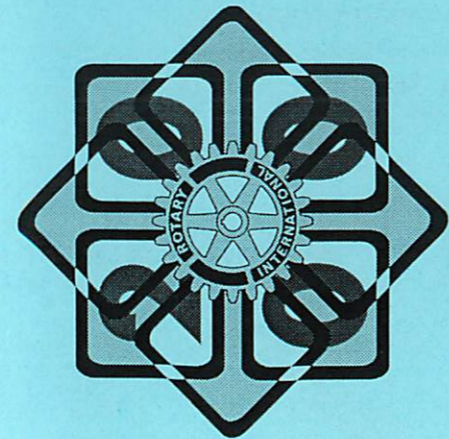

#### **Derrick Ramsey**

**Athletic Director, Kentucky State University**



Derrick Ramsey, the new athletic director for Kentucky State University, will speak at the Rotary Club of Frankfort on Wednesday, Oct. 27. He will be introduced by George W. Reid, program chair for October, and will unveil his vision for athletics at KSU, especially in football and basketball, as well as athletics at KSU in general.

Ramsey was well known throughout Kentucky as the starting quarterback for the University of Kentucky Wildcat football team, as well as a professional football player for 1978-87, playing as a tight end with the Detroit Lions, New England Patriots and Oakland Raiders. In 1999 he was inducted into the Kentucky Athletic Hall of Fame and had his football jersey retired in 1992 by UK. He was a UPI All-American in 1977 and was named a member of the All-Time UK football team in 1994. Since 1995 Ramsey has served UK as director of community relations, working under the vice president for university relations, and also is a director on the board

of the UK Alumni Association. He holds the Lyman T. Johnson Award from UK.

Ramsey earned the BS degree in communications from UK completed in 1981, and is working part-time on a master's in education at UK. Also at UK Ramsey worked to bridge the gap with the African-American community, particularly working with inner city youth in Lexington.

Ramsey has been the color analyst on the University of Kentucky Football Network since 1994 and before that was an account executive with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kentucky.

21.) Scheduled next board meeting for November 22, 1999 at First Federal Savings Bank.

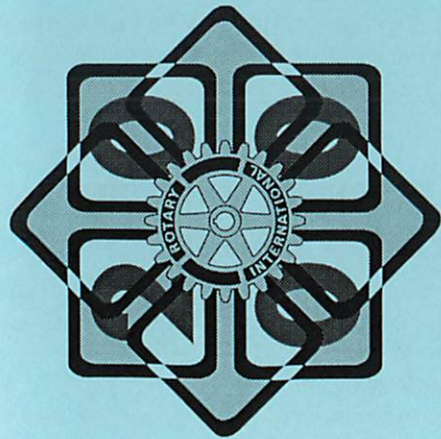
