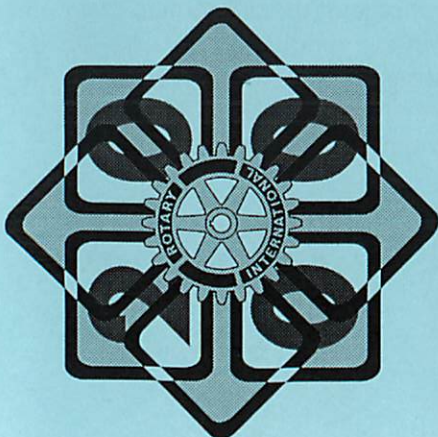

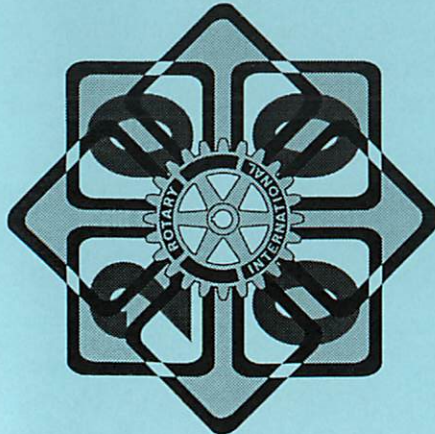

Jim Richardson was born and raised in Frankfort. He graduated from Frankfort High School where he played varsity football and was active in speech.

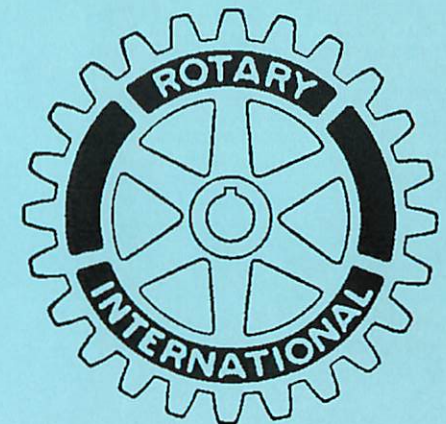

Jim is manager of the Frankfort Cemetery. He certainly has crammed a lot into his life, so far!



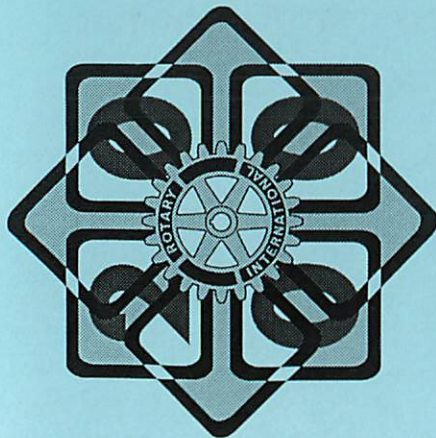

The idea is to expand our presence through advertising our Rotary logo around town. If you are interested, just let us know and we'll take care of you!



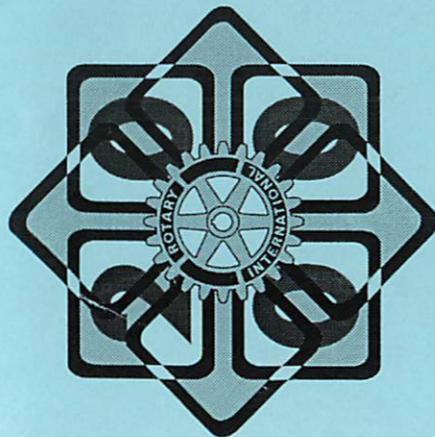

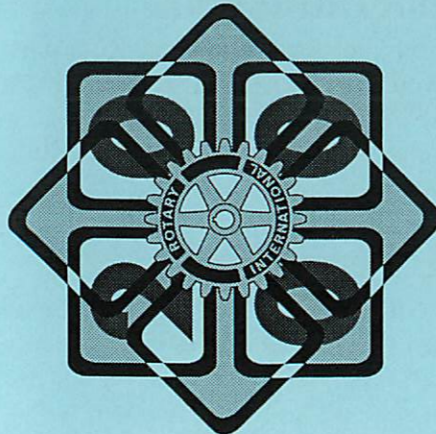
