Ben Chandler To Speak to Frankfort Rotary April 12

Ben Chandler will be the speaker at the Rotary Club of Frankfort April 12, to be introduced by Ted Collins. Chandler was first elected attorney general of Kentucky in 1995, becoming

the youngest attorney general in the nation, and compiling the largest margin of victory in Kentucky's 1995 statewide general election. Chandler was reelected attorney general without opposition in 1999.

He previously served a four-year term as Kentucky state auditor, where he built a strong record of fighting government waste and corruption. His in-depth auditing saved Kentucky millions of dollars and forced dozens of corrupt and wasteful public officials out of office.

As attorney general, Chandler created a new unit in his office to represent the public's interest in health insurance rate hearings. He established a new office dedicated solely to helping senior citizens protect themselves from crime, fraud, and abuse. He also created a public corruption unit in

his office to specialize in uncovering government corruption, staffed by retired FBI agents and state police detectives.

Chandler proposed and won passage of legislation to require violent offenders to serve at least 85 percent of their prison sentences, and he fought successfully to increase the amount of restitution that all criminals must pay to the victims of their crimes. His other successful legislative initiatives include strengthening Kentucky's laws on prescription drug abuse, telemarketing fraud, food stamp trafficking and offenses against the elderly.

Chandler has received numerous awards for his public service including: Kentuckians Voice for Crime Victim's 1998 President's Award; MADD Kentucky's 1997 Outstanding Leadership Award; and Kentucky Bar Association's 1993 Outstanding Young Lawyer Award. He has also received special recognition by the Kentucky County Attorneys Association, Kentucky Victims' Coalition, Kentucky Sheriff's Association, and the Fayette County Peace Officer's Memorial Fund, for service and dedication to those organizations.

Albert Benjamin Chandler III is continuing a tradition of public service started by his grandfather, A. B. "Happy" Chandler a native of Henderson County, who served as Kentucky's governor twice, U.S. Senator, and Commissioner of major league baseball. Ben Chandler lives in Woodford County with his wife Jennifer and their three children Lucie, Albert B. IV and Branham.




President Polly Jo Green and President-elect Bill Miller hold the banner of International President-elect Frank Devlen of Mexico.

Gippy Graham will take the podium for the last Rotary program in April, introduced by Sheriff Ted Collins, program chair for the month. The Franklin County representative will bring us up to date on the recently-concluded session of the Kentucky General Assembly.

Born Feb. 14, 1929 in Franklin County, Graham attended Cumberland College where he was awarded an associate of arts degree. Then it was on to Georgetown College where he completed his bachelor of arts degree, and following that was awarded the master of arts degree from the University of Kentucky. He did further study in educational administration at University of Kentucky and Eastern Kentucky.

Graham is a four-year veteran of the U.S. Air Force. He became a public school teacher, coach, counselor, principal over the span of 12 years. For five years Graham was also college teacher and coach. He was employed as a state government merit employee for 12 years and held non-merit appointments in the Department of Education for two years and the Transportation Cabinet for another two years.

Rep. Graham was elected a member of the Kentucky House in 1995 where he continues to serve.

His committee appointments include being vice-chair of the Economic Development and Tourism Committee, vice chair of the Program Review and Investigations Committee, co-chair Tourism Development and Energy Committee, vice chair of the Education Committee and service on Seniors, Military Affairs, and Public Safety Committee. Graham is chair of the Capitol Caucus.
