Lee graduated from Elkhorn High School where

he played in the band. At one time he was an accomplished trombone player. He went on to UK where he was a member of the "Marching 100", an all male band, under the direction of the great Warren Lutz. They always entered the field, on game day, playing "Dixie." He also studied at George

Washington University and Kentucky State University.

Lee served four years in the US Navy. He served aboard the destroyer *USS Fred B. Royal* during the Cuban blockade.

Lee has been involved in may civic organizations, including president of Downtown Frankfort, Inc., Sister Cities Association, president of Frankfort Rotary Club and president of Elkhorn Landowners Association, just to name a few. He served in the cabinet of Governor Wilkinson as commissioner of Local Government, and was appointed to the Federal Lower Mississippi Delta Development Commission.
