*Next Week's Program...*

July is literacy month for Rotary International and this week's speakers, **Emily Wood** and **Shannan Rome**, will address some of Rotary's previous efforts in this area in the Frankfort community, and in some areas where we may get involved in the future. Emily Wood grew up in beautiful, hot, buggy Charleston, SC. She attended the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where she graduated in 1997 with a B.A. in Child Development and Family Studies. After teaching Pre-Kindergarten in Charlotte-Mecklenburg schools for a year, she decided to serve her country by joining Americorps\*National Civilian Community Corps, a federally-funded service program. She remains in Americorps as a VISTA member serving at the Thornhill Learning Center. There, with three other VISTAs, she coordinates the America Reads Challenge in the local schools, and encourages and fosters partnerships that further literacy in Franklin County. She recently found time to tackle a first-time canoe trip down the Elkhorn... and only got a little wet! Shannan Rome is the director of the Kings Center, a community center in South Frankfort

that provides services to children and families. Shannan has a Bachelor's Degree from Warren Wilson College in Social Work and recently completed her Master's in Social Work from the University of Louisville. She is originally from Berea, Kentucky but has lived for the past two years in Frankfort with her husband Nathan.

**Highlights of July 5 Program**

Bill Miller, Club President for 2000-01, focused on the goals, opportunities and challenges for RI and the local club. He presented a videotape of RI President Frank Devlyn who laid out his goals to create awareness, seek out other groups, and take action on important programs such as membership, Polioplus, literacy, and population reduction. President Bill highlighted the accomplishments covered at the District 6710's meeting in Owensboro in mid-May. He then emphasized that he would like the club to, at least, focus on the following 10 goals:

**Frankfort Rotary Club's Goals for 2000-2001**

1. Recruit 10 new Paul Harris Fellows, 15 Sustaining Members, and 24 new members for the Frankfort Rotary Club.
2. Involve every Rotarian in at least one club committee or activity.
3. Contribute \$4,000 to the Rotary Foundation and re-constitute the Foundation Circles.
4. Identify some innovative and substantive youth related program that will complement our current activities, e.g. the Rotary Youth Fund.
5. Initiate the identification and implementation of a World Community Services Committee Project with our Sister Cities Rotary Club in San Pedro de Macoris, or some other club.
6. Introduce more Rotary related messages, programs, and activities into our weekly meetings.

7. Build upon our excellent public relations outreach to the community and enhance our visibility.

8. Strengthen the excellent substantive club programs that are currently operating, while implementing the new Rotary computer software that will improve our accounting and management.

9. Assist, whenever possible, President Frank Devlyn and District Governor Mary Jo Duke achieve their goals by being involved in the 20 task forces and the Polioplus Program.

10. Create awareness, take action, and enjoy, enjoy, enjoy Rotary Fellowship.
