Mr. Zawacki joined TMMK in March 1987 as manager of materials purchasing and facilities purchasing. # Next Week in Rotary...



#### Justice James E. Keller

Justice James E. Keller, who will speak to Frankfort Rotary on Wednesday April 5, is a native of Harlan County, Kentucky. He attended Eastern Kentucky University on a football scholarship prior to attend-

ing law school at the University of Kentucky. He will be introduced by April program co-chair Ted Collins.

Justice Keller has been married to the former Elizabeth "Beth" Morehead for 37 years. They have two daughters. Denise Keller Harrod is a school teacher at the Elkhorn Middle School here in Frankfort and she is the mother of the Keller's two grandchildren, Tighe and Scarlet. Regina Keller is a graduate of the University of Kentucky Law School and she is now enrolled in the Master Tax Program at the University of Florida Law School.

After practicing law for 10 years, Justice Keller served as a Judge of the Fayette Circuit Court for more than 22 years prior to his appoint-

ment in May of last year by Governor Patton to the Kentucky Supreme Court. He was elected in November of last year to complete the unexpired term of his predecessor, former Chief Justice Robert Stephens. At the time of his appointment as a circuit judge, Justice Keller was the youngest circuit judge in history of the Commonwealth. Now, at 57, after more than 23 years of service, he is first in judicial seniority among Kentucky's more than 250 judges.
