Rtn. PP **NOMAN H. MILLWALA**, 53, is a businessman and the leader of the GSE Team from District 3230 in Chennai, India. After obtaining a graduate degree in bachelor of arts and bachelor of laws, he joined the family business of trading in engineering goods. At present, his firm is also engaged in distribution of generators (both portable and industrial), window and split air-conditioners, domestic pumps. Apart from these activities, he is also a builder and developer of properties. He also specializes in taxation laws.

S. RAVI SELVAN is a 34-year-old engineer, married to Latha, and has a 4-year-old son, Sibi Selvan. Ravi joined the Indian Revenue Service in 1992 after graduating as an engineer from the College Of Engineering in Guindy, Chennai. After a training period of two years as Assistant Commissioner, he was confirmed to the post. This Week's Speaker: Marc Evans

Marc Evans, a senior ecologist with the Kentucky State Nature Preserves Commission (KSNPC) presented this week's program.

The KSNPC is a state agency created in 1976 and directed by five citizens appointed by the governor. The commission's primary mission is to protect Kentucky's natural heritage by identifying, acquiring, and managing natural areas that represent the best known occurrences of rare native species, natural communities, and significant natural features in a statewide nature preserve system. The commission also works with others to protect biological diversity, and to educate Kentuckians as to the value and purpose of nature preserves and biodiversity conservation.

KSNPC currently owns and/or manages 40 nature preserves. These areas encompass 14,821 acres of ecological communities and natural habitat. At present 21 preserves are open to the public throughout the year for non-consumptive recreation such as hiking, birdwatching, photography and nature study.

We thank Marc for his dedication in preserving our natural heritage, and for a very informative program.

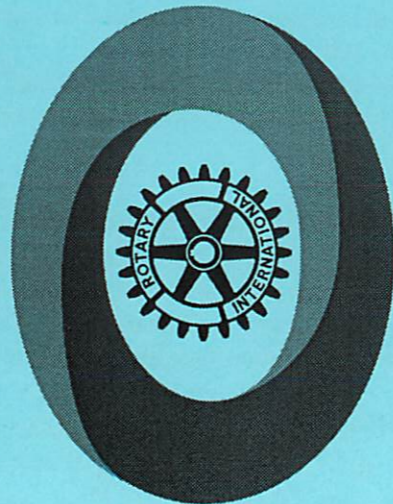
