## This Week's Speaker....

The speaker for the day was Barry Peel, who stated that Kentucky is now a Republican state in ideology if not in party affiliation. He said that Democrats do not seem to realize that Kentucky is a conservative state, and the rise of the religious right was very much in evidence in the last election. The House picked up seven Republican members and there are more Republicans there now since 1968. If repeated in two years, the House will be evenly divided. Republicans effectively used wedge issues like the marriage amendment, and the Democrats dragged this issue out for a month to allow the religious right to mobilize in Frankfort. Concerning the United States Senator race, he observed that the only person who could beat Jim Bunning was Jim Bunning and he almost succeeded in doing just that. This was not just a whispering campaign but was a shouting campaign, and Mitch McConnell saved the day for Bunning. The Democrats will have to become more conservative and in the words of Bob Gable "Gun control is a steady aim." Until Fletcher was elected, every Southern state had elected a Republican except Kentucky.

Thruston Morton stated that the purpose of the political process is to establish a government, and we empower governments with a public mandate to do something. Although the voters apparently told Bush that they want more of the same, it appears that more was omitted than was mandated. He asks just what is Bush's mandate on issues like Social Security, Medicare, and health care. Who will pay for Social Security when the baby boomers retire? The trouble is that there is no mandate to do anything these days. The system is broken because the political process consists of 30-second television ads fueled by obscene amounts of money. The debates are only stylized news conferences and are not really debates. TV is the worst way to communicate and discourages thoughtful debate. Negative campaigns assault the senses and do not against something more than for something. A political process imbued by negativity produces no mandate where nothing is supposed to get done.

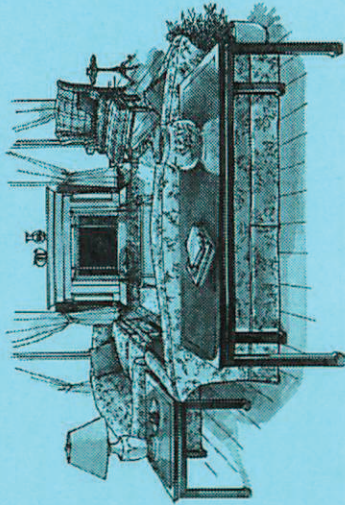

**This Week's Speaker...**

The speaker for the day was the Hon. Derrick Graham, state representative for the 57th district. He reflected on who we are as a people in light of the recent elections, and spoke about the direction in which he feels we are going. While the elections may be over, work of the elected officials goes on. Locally, he observed that the vast majority of people in this community are not comfortable with merger, but the groundwork may have laid more agreements and cooperation between city and county governments. Experience was recognized in the last election with the reelection of Joe Barrows and the election of Julian Carroll. He also thanked Franklin County for giving him the opportunity to continue to serve in the House. In January, the General Assembly will convene for four days to elect leaders and then in February will come back to convene for the short 30-day session. While the health insurance issue was temporarily resolved, there is still the problem of a state budget. There are now 53 Democrats and 47 Republicans in the House. He also observed that while moral values played a big part in this election, he considers providing a decent education for our young people, health care, protecting the elderly, environmental protection, helping the sick and the poor, and hold-

ing corporations accountable to also be moral values. From 1996-2000, 60% of large corporations did not pay taxes in a time of record profits. He hopes that politicians will not misuse the teachings of the Almighty in an attempt to win elections and quoted from a great philosopher who stated that it is better to fail with honor than to succeed by fraud. We must not have a government that governs by fear and suspicion, and it is unfortunately true that some of our brightest and best do not run for office because of the present political climate. Thank you Rep. Graham for a most thought-provoking program.
