

Teresa Barton, Executive Director of the Office of Drug Control Policy "Status of Substance Abuse in Kentucky"

Governor Ernie Fletcher appointed Teresa Barton as Executive Director of the Office of Drug Control Policy on February 16, 2005.

She was elected as Franklin County's first female Judge/Executive in 1998 and served until 2005. 

Rotary Profile: Marcie Jeffreys






