Paul Gillespie, Methodist Children's Home

The Kentucky Methodist Children's Homes is a non-profit organization serving all ages of children through a variety of programs. The Home was originally established in 1871 as the Widows and Orphans Home by the Methodist Episcopal Church South in Louisville, Sixty years later, the Home was moved to Versailles. Kentucky. The original mission – to rescue women and children from abuse, serve unwed mothers, and provide housing for homeless and orphaned children - is historically similar to that of today's mission. However in the late 1980s, our Home changed from being an orphanage to a treatment facility in order to serve adolescent children with histories of abuse, neglect, abandonment, and family trauma. In 1984, the Home purchased property in Owensboro, also known as the Mary Kendall Home. In 1993, our new name became "The Kentucky United Methodist Homes for Children and Youth." Throughout its history, this ministry has always made children a top priority. All of this is possible because years ago compassionate Christians united to help children who were thrown into desperate situations.



This Week's Speaker...

The speakers for the day were Reverend Pearl Gillespie, Vice President for Spiritual Life and Chaplain at The United Methodist Homes for Children and Youth, and Sha'Meka Gilmore, former resident and currently a student at Kentucky State University majoring in Criminal Justice. Reverend Gillespie stated that the Methodist Home is for abused and neglected children between the ages of 12 and 17. The facility is multicultural and ecumenical, and reaches youth to give hope. The average stay is nine months, and the Home can house about 60 youths at one time. Some 10-12 go off-campus to school. She attempts to present Jesus Christ to these children to help them get through somewhat messy lives. She stated that it is a rare privilege to make a difference in these young lives who have various problems in their troubled youths. She believes in the healing power of God's love. Sha'Meka then told how as a freshman at K.S.U. she is turning her life around having been both neglected and abused at home. Reverend Gillespie helped her keep her faith strong. She came to the Home while a high school senior, graduated, and is now on the Dean's List at Kentucky State. Thank you Kelli for bringing us a most interesting and informative program.






Hugely Successful Bell-ringing

- * Scheduled next board meeting for January 22, 2007.



Rotaractors and Rotarians spread holiday cheer in Western Australia

Santa Claus is coming to Western Australia, thanks to the Dial-A-Santa program created by Rotaractors in District 9470. For a nominal fee, anyone in Districts 9450 and 9470 in Western Australia can have Santa Claus to visit their holiday party.

The program began 25 years ago and has since raised more than A\$140,000 (about US\$110,000) for children's charities and medical research, including a post-graduate research scholarship. Rotaractors from District 9470 and 9450 work together to raise about \$4,000 every year. They charge \$50 per half hour for a Christmas party and \$25 per family for a Christmas Eve visit. Rotaractors do all the planning, booking, and arranging. A few years ago, they began working with Rotarians in their districts, recruiting them as Santas and helpers.

The vast majority of Santas are Rotarians, and the Rotaractors act as Santas' helpers. All of the Santa suits are handmade. Initially, they were made by Rotaractors, but the newest suits are handmade by Rotarians.

Simone Collins, Dial-A-Santa committee chair, says that she knew about the program long before joining the Rotaract Club of South Perth. "My family had a Rotaract Santa visit one of our Christmas parties when I was seven years old, and it was one of the most memorable Christmas parties ever."

According to Collins, working in conjunction with Rotarians has really paid off for the Rotaractors. "Most of the Rotarians get a real buzz out of the visits. They love the reaction of the children. It works really well to have Rotarians rather than Rotaractors play Santa, as the Rotarians usually make more convincing Santas. And they usually have more experience interacting with children."

The incoming president of the Mill Point Rotary club, Peter Kraj-Krajewski, agrees. "As a Rotarian, I get a great kick out of working with the people who order the Dial-A-Santa service. Usually they are children – the joy on people's faces when they receive personalized attention from Santa is just great."

Kraj-Krajewski says that he enjoys working with Rotaractors as well. "It gives Rotarians a new zest for life and some of the youthful zeal rubs off. [In addition], being involved with Rotaractors may encourage them to consider being Rotarians later."

Collins says Dial-A-Santa is a project that other Rotaract clubs could easily replicate. In fact, she is finishing a manual on how to run the entire project.


