Jan Gould, President Kentucky Retailers Federation

Mr. Gould is the Executive and lobbyist for this statewide retail trade association based in Frankfort representing retail businesses, pharmacies, restaurants, agribusiness dealers and the propane gas industry. He has nearly 30 years of political and lobbying experience. He has worked on the campaigns of a former US Congressman and a gubernatorial candidate. Prior to coming to the Federation, Mr. Gould worked as an on-air personality and producer for a Lexington radio station.

Mr. Gould received a BA in Communications from the University of Kentucky in 1980. He completed a six-year organizational management training program at the University of Notre Dame in 1990. Mr. Gould was named one of the ten most influential lobbyists in Kentucky by the Kentucky Center for Public Issues. 
