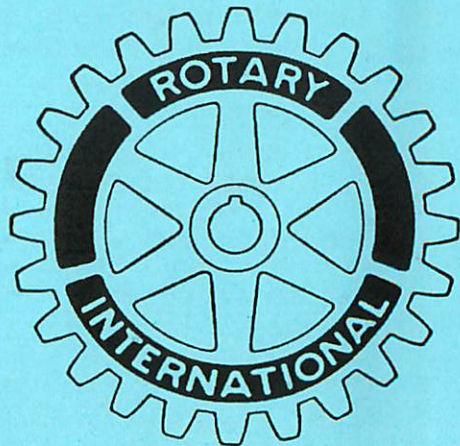

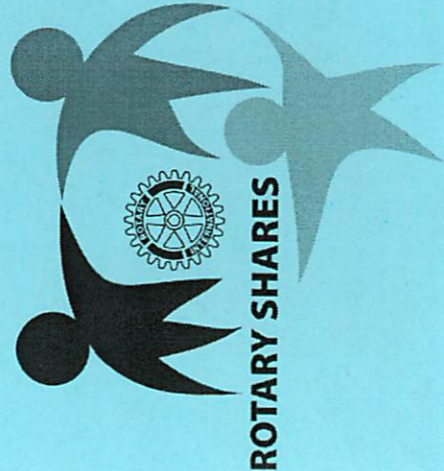

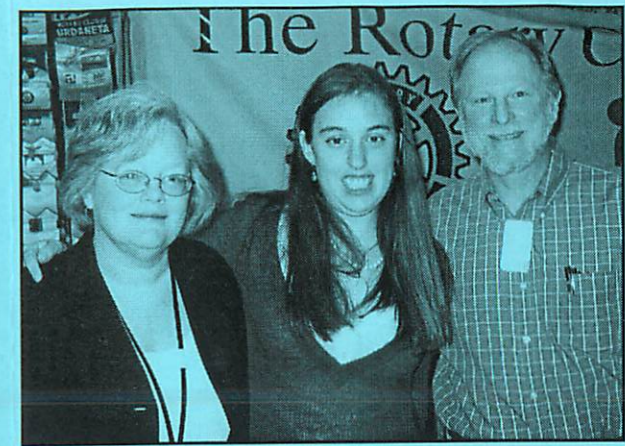
\* Reviewed attendance report. No action taken.

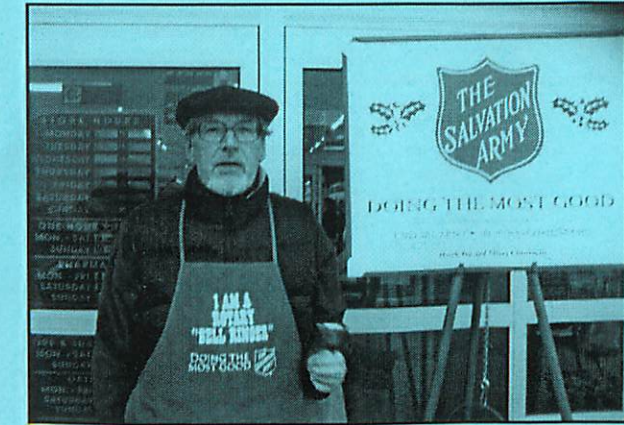

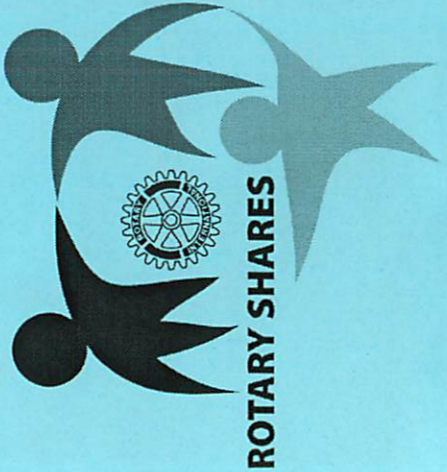
