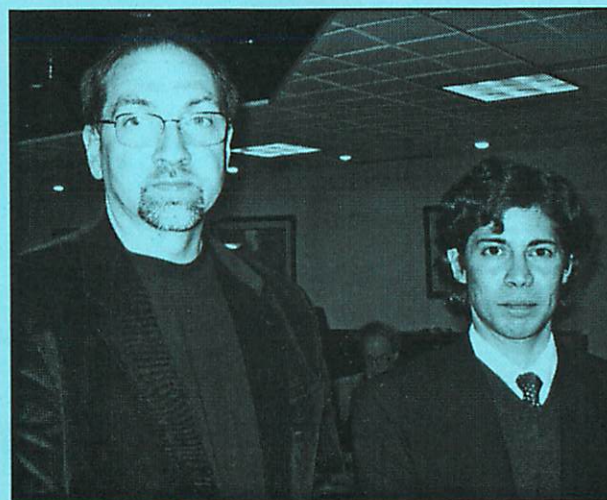

**Rotary and Women's Shelter**

Our Rotary club is joining other local organizations in furnishing Frankfort's new women's shelter. Our assignment for the project is the combination living room (common area) and kitchen in Apt. 3. Because the living room area is rather small, furniture must be scaled to make optimal use of the space. Seating for 6 to 8 people -- perhaps a small/medium-size sofa, small/medium-size armchairs, a small (perhaps folding) dinette with matching chairs, etc.; TV wall mount rack; Small end tables and/or a set of TV tables (4 tables and storage rack); Small table lamps and/or floor lamps; Trashcan; Valences for two double windows.

Kitchen: The kitchen in "our" apartment will be used only for preparing snacks, warming up prepared food, etc. No meals will be cooked in this apartment. Also, there is rather limited counter space. They need: Toaster oven; Red-handled utensils (to match existing items); Coffee pot; Can opener (manual or electric); Trashcan; Kitchen supplies like paper towels, zip lock bags, paper napkins, paper plates, etc. There is not much storage space so a limited amount of these items can be accommodated.

Andy McDonald, co-chair of the Frankfort Mayor's Task Force on Energy Efficiency and Climate Change, will discuss the findings and recommendations of the Task Force and local efforts underway to address the global crisis of climate change. The presentation will place local efforts in the context of the national and international movement to stop global warming and mitigate climate change.

Andy is the coordinator of the Kentucky Solar Partnership, a project of the non-profit organization Appalachia - Science in the Public Interest, and co-author of "The Kentucky Solar Energy Guide." He has a Master's Degree in Sustainable Systems from Slippery Rock University and a BA in Philosophy from the University of Buffalo. He is a co-founder and Chair of the Kentucky Solar Energy Society.

Andy has been working to promote a socially-just, sustainable society for over 15 years and has worked on sustainable development projects in Kentucky, Pennsylvania, the Texas-Mexico border, and Peru. He lives with his wife and step-daughter on a farm in Franklin County where his wife operates an organic market garden.

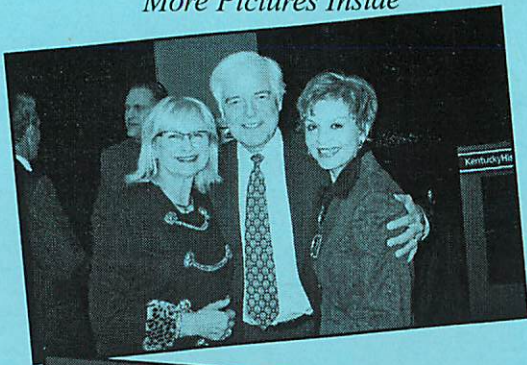

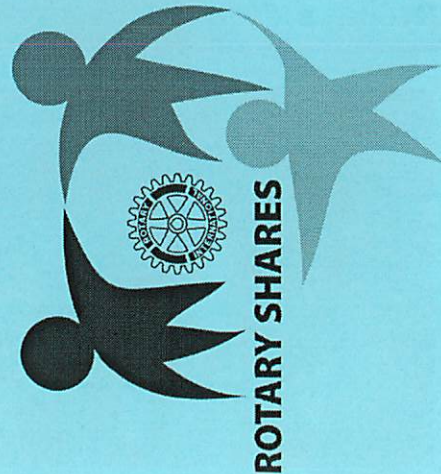
