This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Nikki Jackson, Personnel Secretary for state government. She stated that state employees have expectations beyond the paycheck, which include being safe physically, and being free from harassment and a hostile work environment, as well as being appreciated and respected for their work. Managers often fail to understand the purpose of management. What we are currently witnessing is the rebirth of the Personnel Cabinet, which is undergoing a strategic transformation. It is not a question of thinking outside the box because there are no boxes since state employees are our customers and we must do everything possible to secure their safety and well-being. The Beshear administration has established a Department for Strategic Innovation, which consists of seven employees servicing the areas of communication and customer service. The strategic focus here is in four areas: (1) How do we help the Commonwealth to be an employer of choice? We need to condition employees to think in terms of their empowerment since they have been conditioned in the past to think only of their paychecks and benefits. (2) How do we look like one employer? We tend to see the department of state government as acting like little businesses. The steps a typical employee goes through are courting the employee, recruiting the employee, performance management while they are an employee, and exiting state employment either voluntarily or involuntarily. These are the employee life cycles and we need to build bridges to help the employee in all aspects of his employment. (3) How do we create a learning and developmental environment? (4) How do we discern customer value in a different way? In order to make state government more competitive, cabinet-to-cabinet meetings will be held quarterly. Vital connections made to employees as customers will further help state government to be more competitive.

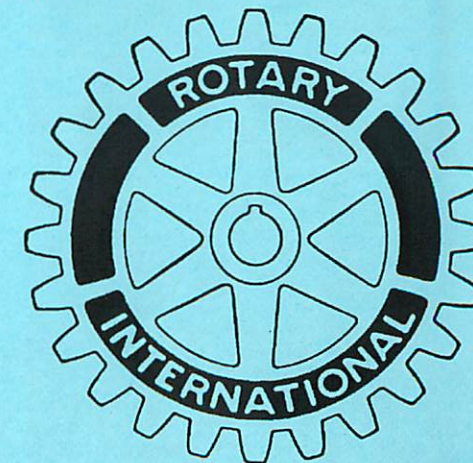

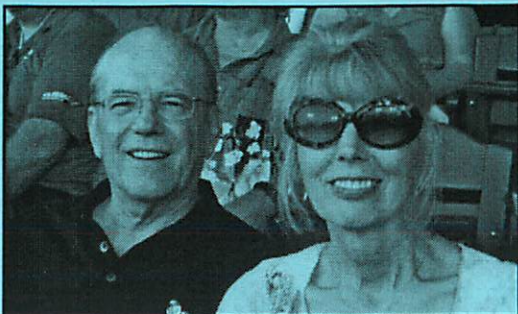

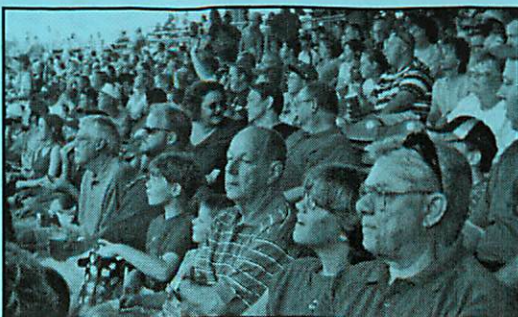
- Approved the minutes from the June 2008 board meeting.
