Russ Barnett is the Director of the University of Louisville's Kentucky Institute for the Environment and Sustainability, which conducts research and classes on sustainability. He has studied sustainability issues in the Republic of Georgia, Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Taiwan and China. He took 18 students in a class he taught on Global Environmental Issues to Taiwan and China last year, and returned with 17. His areas of research include public health and air toxins, renewable energy, and water resources. Russ is a KCC Past President (2002-2003) and member since 1980. Formerly, he was Deputy Commissioner of the Kentucky Department of Environmental Protection; EPA Scientist, Atlanta; Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg. Currently, Russ is the Chair of the Salt River Watershed Watch and a Sierra Club member.
