

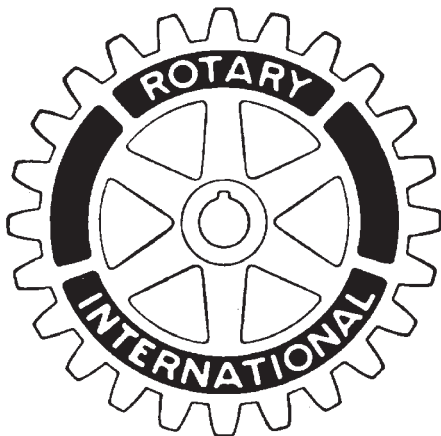

Next Week's Speaker...

Jim Waters is president of the Bluegrass Institute for Public Policy Solutions, a free-market think tank with offices in Bowling Green and Lexington. Jim spent more than two decades in newspapers and radio stations as a reporter, editor and anchor. Since coming to the institute in 2003, his articles have been published statewide



and in national publications, including the *Wall Street Journal*. He has also been a guest on CNN television. His weekly *Bluegrass Beacon* column appears in several newspapers across the commonwealth, including the *Owensboro Messenger-Inquirer*, *Elizabethtown News-Enterprise* and *Paducah Sun*. Jim's columns have included strong, nonpartisan stands for school choice and enlightening information about how politicians are using the pension systems to buy votes and curry political favor. He travels extensively, promoting liberty, free markets and smaller government on media outlets across Kentucky. He is in demand as a public speaker. Along with frequent appearances

on radio and television programs, including *Kentucky Tonight*, he often serves as a guest host on radio talk shows in Lexington and Louisville. Jim currently appears on 84WHAS every other Monday from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. during the *Mandy Connell Show*, offering the kind of information that empowers Kentuckians to take back their freedoms.
