This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Greg Coker who asks whether we are "cathedral builders" in our Rotary Club. He along with Sherrill Smith and Dave Weller helped start the Rotary scholarship fund 20 years ago. Sherrill was president, later followed by Judge Palmore. Greg was the facilitator and Dave was the motivating force behind it all. Greg gave us the example of the English architect, Christopher Wren, who rebuilt St. Paul's Cathedral after the 1666 fire that destroyed London. Wren was not just an architect but also a scientist, doctor and inventor. He never sought credit for his own inventions and achievements by not patenting his creations. He not only built St. Paul's but also 75 other churches destroyed by the fire. He was an outstanding example of one who produces, constructs and inspires others. Greg asked the question "how visionary is our Club?" He gave the example of a vision fulfilled of the Rotary-inspired eradication of polio in the world. However, to be a cathedral builder, one must be in good physical and mental shape and ethical in dealings with others. He also asked whether in our endeavors we are building cathedrals or are we merely tearing down other people's cathedrals?
