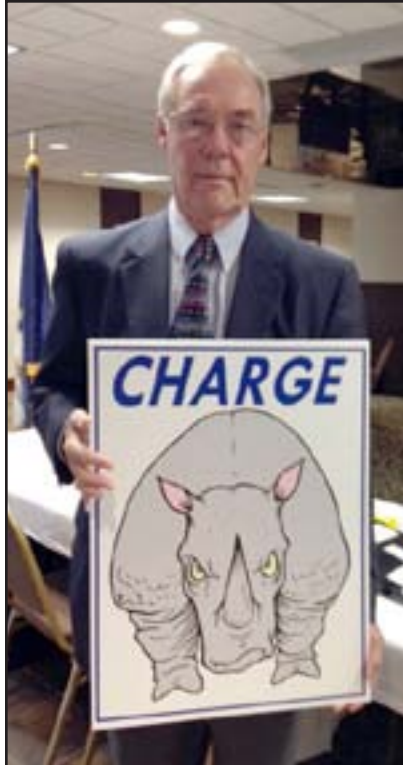

He then transferred to James City/County Fire Department where he rose through the ranks to district fire chief. In 1994, he was appointed fire chief of the South Burlington, Vt., fire department, serving until 1998. In 1998 Possich became the fire chief for Frankfort. Chief Possich serves on the Board of the International Association of Fire Chiefs. He holds a degree in Fire Science and Administration and is one of the 12,000 certified International Fire Engineers.
