**Dr. Michael Cairo** is an Associate Professor of Political Science and director of the International Affairs program at Transylvania University, established in 1780, in Lexington. He has previously taught at Virginia Commonwealth University, Southern Illinois University – Carbondale, University of Wisconsin – Stevens Point,



and Georgetown College. His first book, *The Gulf: The Bush Presidencies and the Middle East*, published in November 2012, focuses on conflict, diplomacy, and peace. Dr. Cairo has also written numerous book chapters and book reviews focusing on American diplomacy. His next project examines American diplomacy in the Middle East peace process from the LBJ to the Obama administrations.

- Scheduled next board meeting for March 18, 2013.

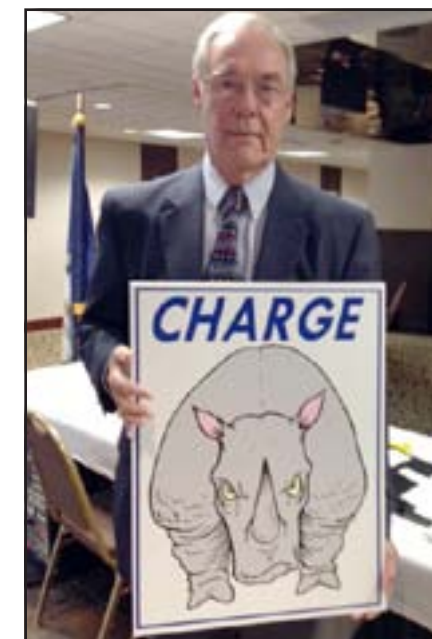
