There was a time when the words that describe **A. Hasan Davis** would have been delinquent, troublemaker or thug. Determined to prove that his past failures would not be his only legacy, he earned his GED and relocated to



Kentucky to attend Berea College. Hasan earned his BA degree from Berea College and a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Kentucky College of Law. He has served as Director of the Lexington Youth Violence Prevention Project, Chair of the Kentucky Juvenile Justice Advisory Board, Vice Chair of the Federal Advisory Committee on Juvenile Justice, Regional Board Representative on the Council of Educators of At-Risk and Delinquent Youth and earned a fellowship with the Rockefeller Foundation's Next Generation Leadership program. Today Hasan is the Commissioner of the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice, and continues to be sought after as a speaker and presenter in the areas of education, juvenile justice and the arts, on the local, state, and national level.
